All SAY students and students will have regular meeting with academic staff throughout the course in order to mentor, advice and monitor the students' academic progression.

Visa Process

- Students need to book and pay for the full course before departure for Ireland
- Students must have a minimum of 4 weeks accommodation organised in advance
- Students must have medical insurance organised in advance
- When you arrive at the airport, Immigration usually stamp your passport with a visa for one month

To validate your visa after arrival in Ireland, you need to:

- Open a bank account and deposit €3,000 in that bank account (GCI help you with the procedures)
- Get letters from the bank, the school and proof of medical insurance
- Go to Immigration (GNIB) with your passport and all the necessary documents (we help you with the procedures)
- The visa / IRP Irish Residence Permit card costs €300
