



## Growing and caring for rapid-cycling brassicas


Read these instructions carefully before you start.




1. Pipette drops of water from above for the first 2-3 days.



2. On day 4, transplant surplus seedlings to fill any blank minipots.




3. On day 4 or 5, thin to one strong seedling in each minipot.




4. If plants need supporting use ring ties and stakes.




5. Bees pollinate many flowers including brassicas.



6. You may use a dead bee, to pollinate your flowers.



7. Lay the can on its side and 'attach' it to the bench with blutack making sure that the mark/snip on the lid is at the top. Keep it in a warm place.



8. After about 1 hour carefully remove the lid and observe the hypocotyl (stalk). If there is no change, leave it for longer.
