

Current practice to lessen transmission risk - Helicopter

NB - Information current at time of issue on 07/01/21 - it is not exhaustive and is not intended to replace existing obligations for managing wider health, safety and environmental aspects

Ref.	Measure Description	Status
1	Ear defenders and lifejackets, particularly PSTASS sets sanitised between all flights	
2	Survival suits sanitised between issues	
3	Aircraft deep cleaned every evening with further sanitisation taking place between every flight	
4	Consideration for IOGP guidance that only disposable earplugs used as lessens the risks of virus spread between flights using ear defenders	
5	Helicopter operator recommendations on social distancing on all aircraft types up to the point of face covering being issued	
6	Use of issued Virustatic snoods during transit to and from installations – issued for each trip	
7	Use delegated 'COVID-copters' for patient transit – agreed between operators	
8	Designated helicopter seating to allow more accurate and timely contact tracing if necessary	
9	Screens segregating pilots from passengers within the aircraft
