

Leave No Trace on the Loops

Ensure you have the fitness, equipment and time needed for the loop you choose. Check the weather forecast and be prepared for changing weather conditions

2 Be Considerate of Other People Park appropriately – do not block entrances or other cars. Leave gates as you find them.

Do not damage property. 3 Respect Farm Animals and Wildlife Dogs should be kept under control. Keep a safe distance from farm animals.

Leave habitats, plants and animals as you find them.

4 Protect the Environment No smoking. Do not light fires. Leave no litter – if you bring it in, take it out! Prevent erosion - stick to the official trail.
