

CERTIFICATE IN FLUORIDE VARNISH APPLICATION

ABOUT THIS COURSE

The Certificate in Fluoride Varnish Application is a post-registration certificate in competency. This provides established dental nurses with additional training which will enable them to provide effective fluoride varnish application within a community-based setting, on prescription from a dentist or as part of a structured dental health program.

DURATION

4 months

COSTS

LEARNER ELIGIBILITY

- Dental Nurse, Dental Hygienist or Therapist
- GDC Registration
- 6 months post registration experience
- Up to date CPD and PDP
- Clinical Supervisor
- Adequate patient access for ROC completion

HOW IS THE COURSE DELIVERED?

This course is designed to provide students with the knowledge and understanding of Fluoride Varnish application.

The course takes place over four months, with a live online induction, a live online, evening-based, teaching session with specialist dental nursing tutors, followed by 5 hours scenario-based independent learning modules, aligned with GDC standard, delivering essential underpinning knowledge.

There is no exam for the qualification.

CLINICAL COMPETENCE

Learners will need to complete 10 fluoride applications for the Record of Competence (ROC), consisting of a minimum of 2 adults.

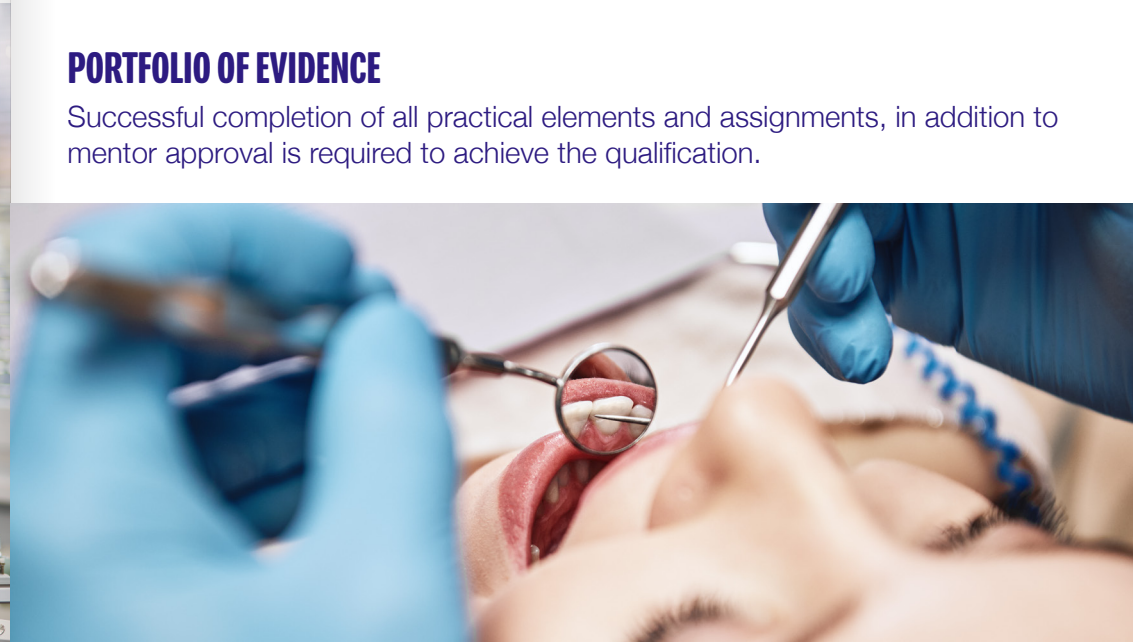
Reflections on these applications will be recorded on the ROC and signed off by a GDC registrant.

KNOWLEDGE ASSESSMENT

Finally, learners will complete a 500-word assignment.

PORTFOLIO OF EVIDENCE

Successful completion of all practical elements and assignments, in addition to mentor approval is required to achieve the qualification.
