

FUNDAMENTALS OF INTRA-ORAL SCANNING AND CLINICAL PHOTOGRAPHY

COURSE STRUCTURE

ENROLMENT

The course is suited to nurses who aspire to treat patients directly and to take intra oral scans and clinical photographs under the prescription of a registered dentist or clinical dental technician.

To enrol, you must be GDC-registered, work in surgery and hold indemnity insurance (extended duties). You will need a GDC registered dental professional able and willing to supervise you.

STRUCTURE

The course is held over 5 hours with our specialist Tutor (7hrs CPD inc. Record of Competence completion) - covering the following learning objectives:

- Explain the Health & Safety regulations which govern 10S and photography.
- Identification and use of equipment.
- Describe the principles of patient assessment.
- List the indications and limitations of the different software.
- To be able to take accurate intra oral photographs and scans.

COURSE SPECIFICATIONS

You will then complete a minimum of 5 intra oral scans and 5 clinical photographs for your Record of Competence, via our e-portfolio.

This will demonstrate your ability to grade and reflect upon your intra oral scan and clinical photography techniques and demonstrate your competence unsupervised under prescription.

Complete 5 intra oral scans and 5 clinical photographs on either adults or child patients. Reflections on these to be noted and recorded on your record of competence. Signed off by your in-house mentor.

Finally, you will complete a 500-word essay on the different types of intra oral scans and clinical photographs and patient support.





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
