

Mercer Residences Palau Moxó

Barcelona



Welcome to one of the most valuable palaces in Barcelona

Built between 1730 and 1750 under the direction of Francesc Mestres -Master of Works of the Cathedral of Barcelona-, this urban palace was designed as the Moxó family residence, prominent representatives of the local aristocracy.

The Palau -which belonged to this same lineage until 2017- became one of the most outstanding private residences in the city and one of the most beautiful examples of 18th century civil baroque architecture preserved to this day in the old town of Barcelona.

With 2.800sqm (30.139sqft), Palau Moxó is protected as a Cultural Asset of Local Interest and it is part of the Barcelona Catalogue of Historical Artistic Architectural Heritage.

For around 300 years, the influential Moxó family opened their residence halls and patios to celebrate receptions where Barcelona's high society and foreign personalities visiting the city were usually invited.

Now the Palau different spaces as the old stables on the ground floor, as well as the different halls and the Italian patio on the main floor -with enormous historical, architectural and symbolic value- adapt to the 21st century to host select events of hall kind where the city's past and present discreetly converge.

The spaces grandeur, the nobility of its elements and the beauty of its restoration create a unique setting for high-level celebrations, where you can revive the splendour and romanticism of the 18th century in the heart of the most cosmopolitan Barcelona.

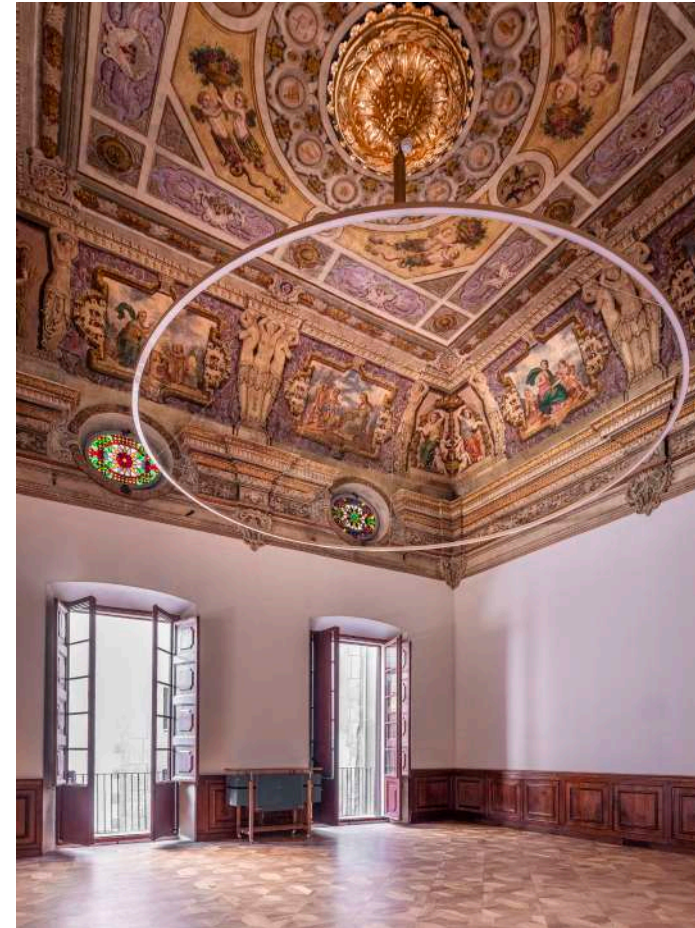

Sant Mori Hall

This was once the grand ballroom of the Moxó family and today it's one of the Palau's greatest treasures.

This rococo-style hall preserves a magnificent 18th-century ceiling repainted in the 19th century with detailed pictorial decoration representing the seasons of the year, among other allegories common to that period. In contrast, a huge circular pendant lamp created by Josep Lluís Xuclà transports us to the present. This marvelous hall is an invitation to travel back in time imagining the Moxó family and the Barcelona aristocracy public life.

Montcortés Hall

The Montcortés hall is a rectangular room that opens onto Plaça Sant Just through two large balconies with direct views to the Basilica of Sant Just: A hall of great beauty which was originally used for the Moxó family social activities. It is presided over by a marble fireplace and has original carpentry details (18th century). But above all, the pictorial ornamentation of the ceiling and walls stands out, with vibrant floral decorations in gilded frames (19th century). It is a truly palatial hall, named after Mr. Bonaventura de Moxó and Montcortés Baron, the first of his lineage to reside in the Palau from 1775.

Rocabertí Hall

This rectangular hall was once the Moxó family dining room. Renovated in the 19th century, it stands out for the four arches gallery opening onto the ancient stables courtyard, the moulded and gilded wooden ceiling, the solid walnut floor and the neoclassical -inspired fireplace. Historical elements coexist with modern circular pendant lamps designed by Josep Lluís Xuclà in a palace that looks to the 21st century, creating a unique atmosphere, perfect for private events with charm and personality. In addition, Rocabertí hall connects with Sant Mori hall.

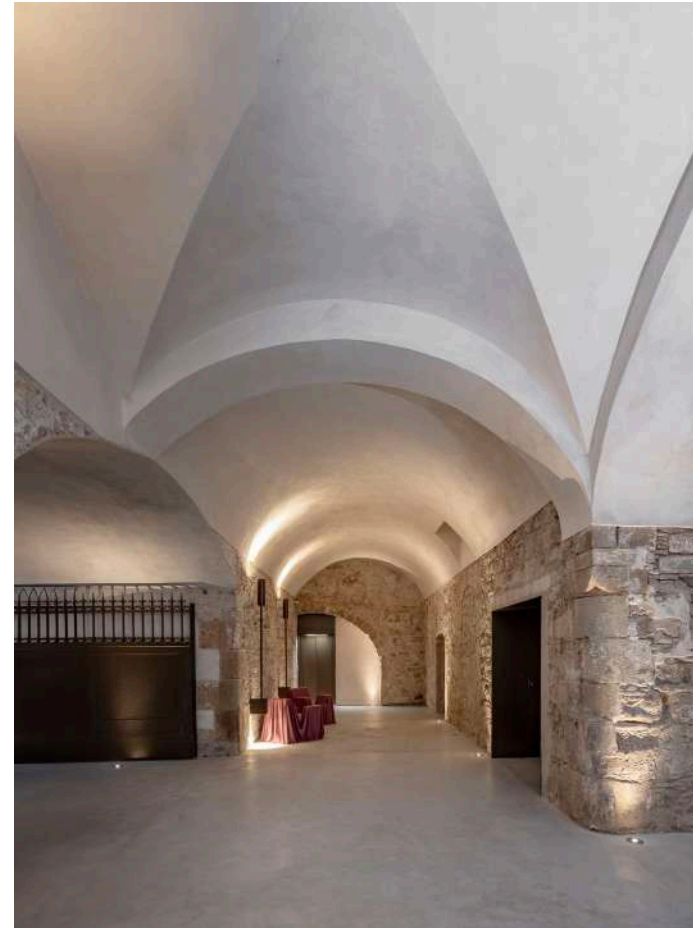
Old stables and coach house

Behind the Palau main entrance door in Plaça Sant Just is the old stables courtyard and the coach house, part of the most emblematic elements of the architectural complex.

From the stables patio there is the access to the noble floor through the honor staircase -unique in Barcelona-.

Coach house has a typical structure of medieval residences, with exposed stone walls and beautiful original vaults.

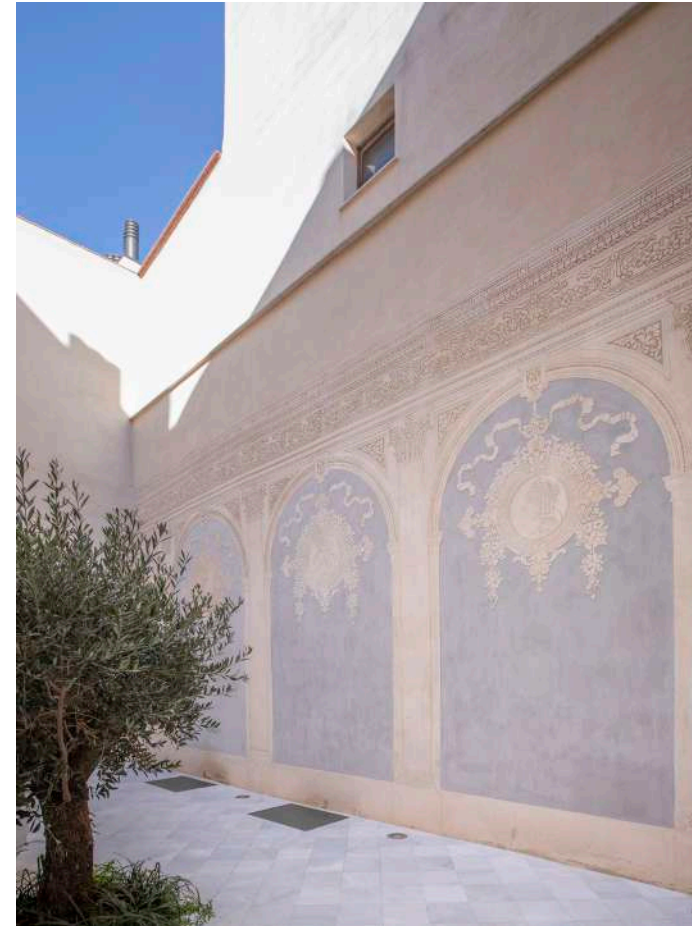

Italian patio







The so-called Italian Patio is an elevated patio characteristic of 18th-century Barcelona residential architecture. Conceived as one of the representative rooms on the noble floor, the patio was a large open-air lounge where the lords of the house and their guests used to take the fresh air during important occasions. The pavement and its large grey marble slabs stand out, as do the wonderful sgraffito adorning one of its walls and two sober olive trees. This charming patio for an open-air event connects with the library of the Palau and the wedding Suite.



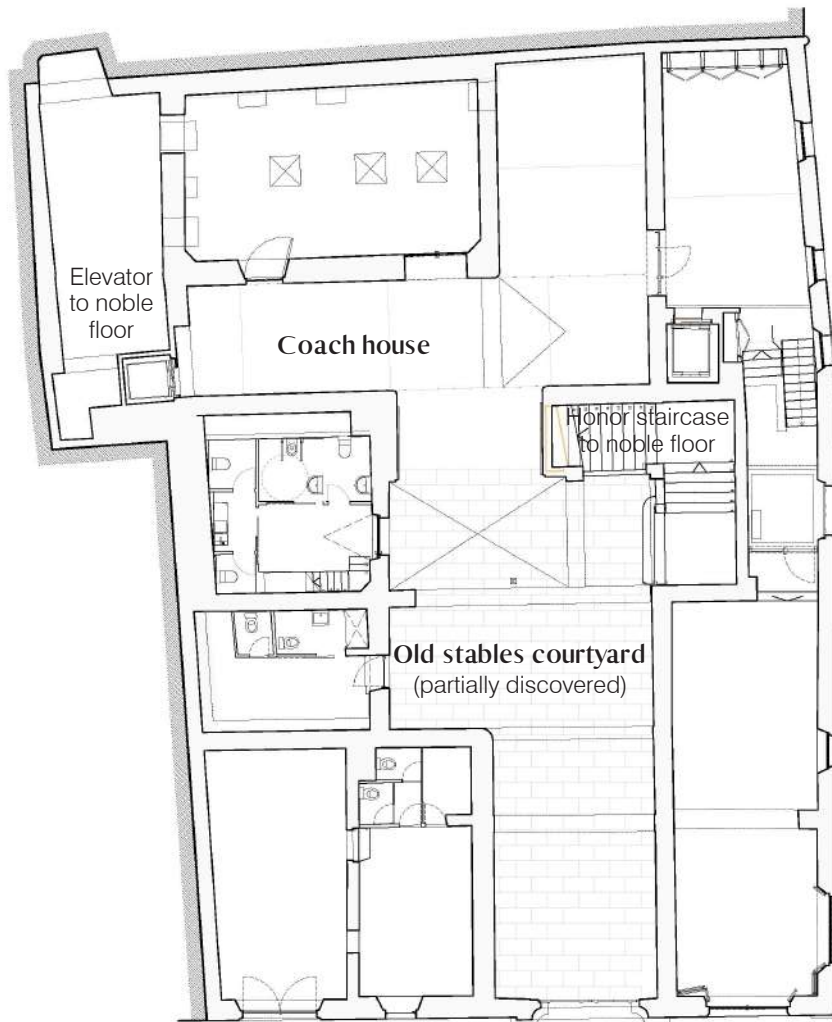

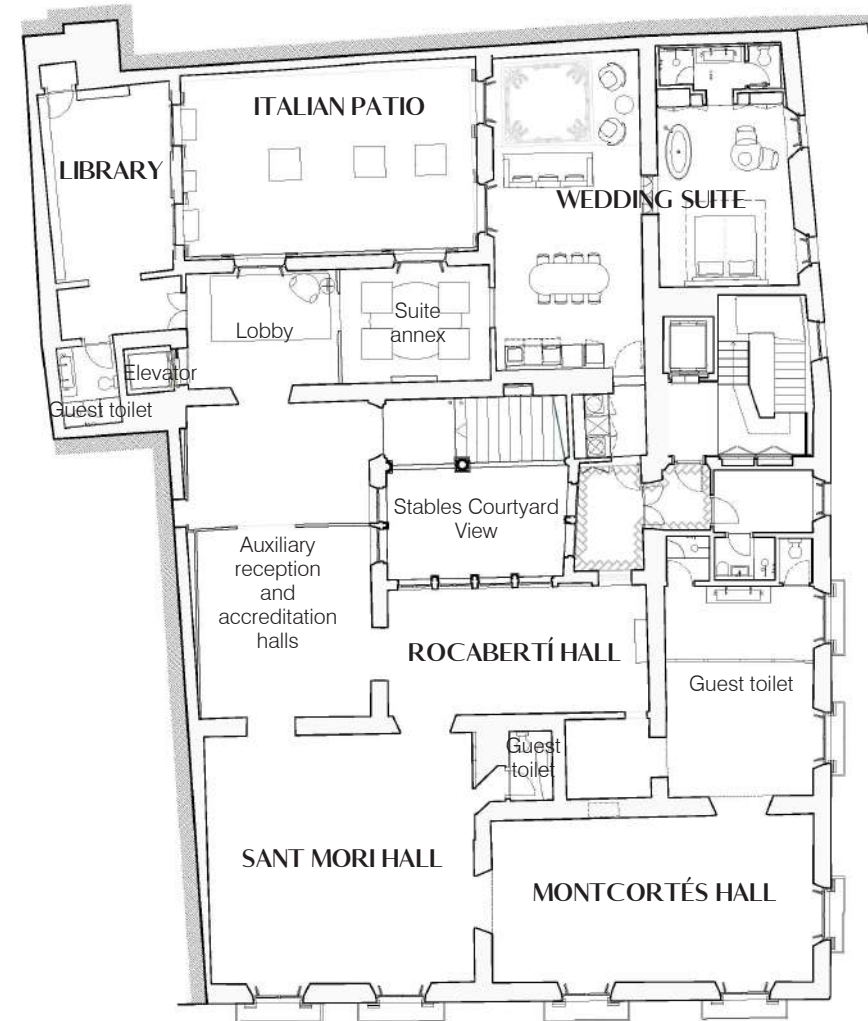
