India's recent losses to South Africa and Australia

The tournament co-hosts began their campaign strongly with victories against Sri Lanka and Pakistan but have since endured a challenging run. India's fortunes took a downturn with a three-wicket defeat to South Africa in Visakhapatnam, followed by another heart-breaking loss to Australia despite posting a formidable total of 330. Most recently, India fell short by just four runs against England at Indore's Holkar Stadium.

Notably, in all three defeats, India had been in winning positions but failed to close out the matches. Against Australia, they couldn't defend 330, while South Africa chased down 251 despite being seven wickets down. Against England, India needed just 55 runs from 53 balls with seven wickets in hand, yet ultimately fell short.

England's unbeaten run and current form

Meanwhile, England has secured their semifinal berth alongside Australia and South Africa with a fourth win in five matches. They remain unbeaten in the tournament after their match against Pakistan was abandoned due to rain. England's captain Heather Knight has been in exceptional form, scoring a brilliant century (109 off 91 balls) in her 300th international appearance during their clash with India.

England's bowling attack has demonstrated remarkable resilience, particularly in the closing stages of matches. Their ability to hold their nerve under pressure was evident in the final overs against India, where they successfully defended their total despite India's strong position.

Why this match is crucial for India's semifinal hopes

With Australia, England, and South Africa having already secured their places in the semifinals, only one spot remains up for grabs. With four points from five matches (NRR +0.526), ahead of New Zealand who also has four points but with a lower net run-rate (-0.245). [India currently sits fourth in the standings](#)

For India to guarantee their semifinal spot, they must win their remaining two matches against New Zealand on Thursday and Bangladesh on Sunday. Should they lose to New Zealand, India would need the White Ferns to lose their final match against England and then beat Bangladesh themselves to advance. Additionally, if India beats New Zealand but loses to Bangladesh, and New Zealand defeats England, qualification will come down to net run-rate.

The upcoming match against New Zealand at DY Patil Stadium in Navi Mumbai has essentially become a knockout contest for Harmanpreet Kaur's side.
