

The Campaign Against Drag, consisting of members of Huddersfield Polytechnic Union Lesbian and Gay Society, handed out leaflets which claimed that: "DRAG takes the piss out of women" and reinforces the myth that gay men

Christopher Eymard, host for the day on the open stage, gave the students a quick history lesson, pointing out that in the Stonewall Riots which Pride commemorates: "the people that led them were the mad drag queens of Christopher Street."
