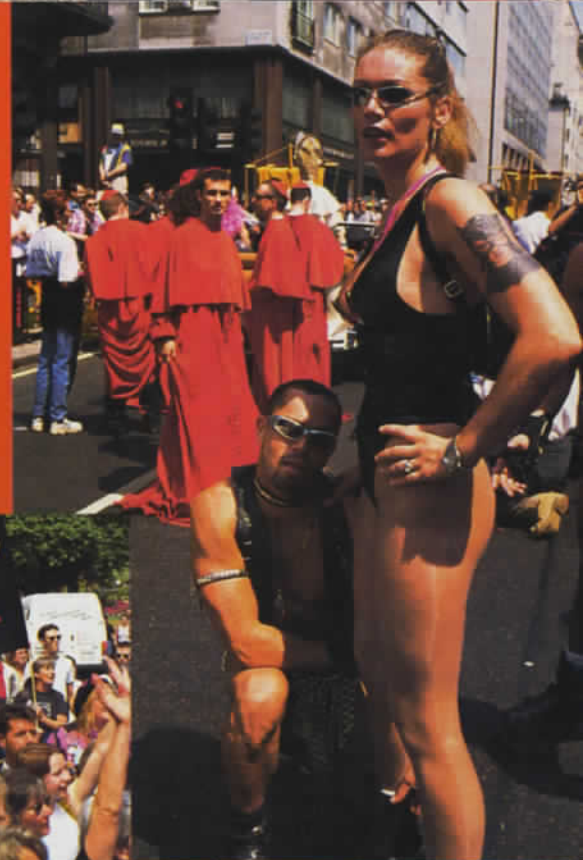


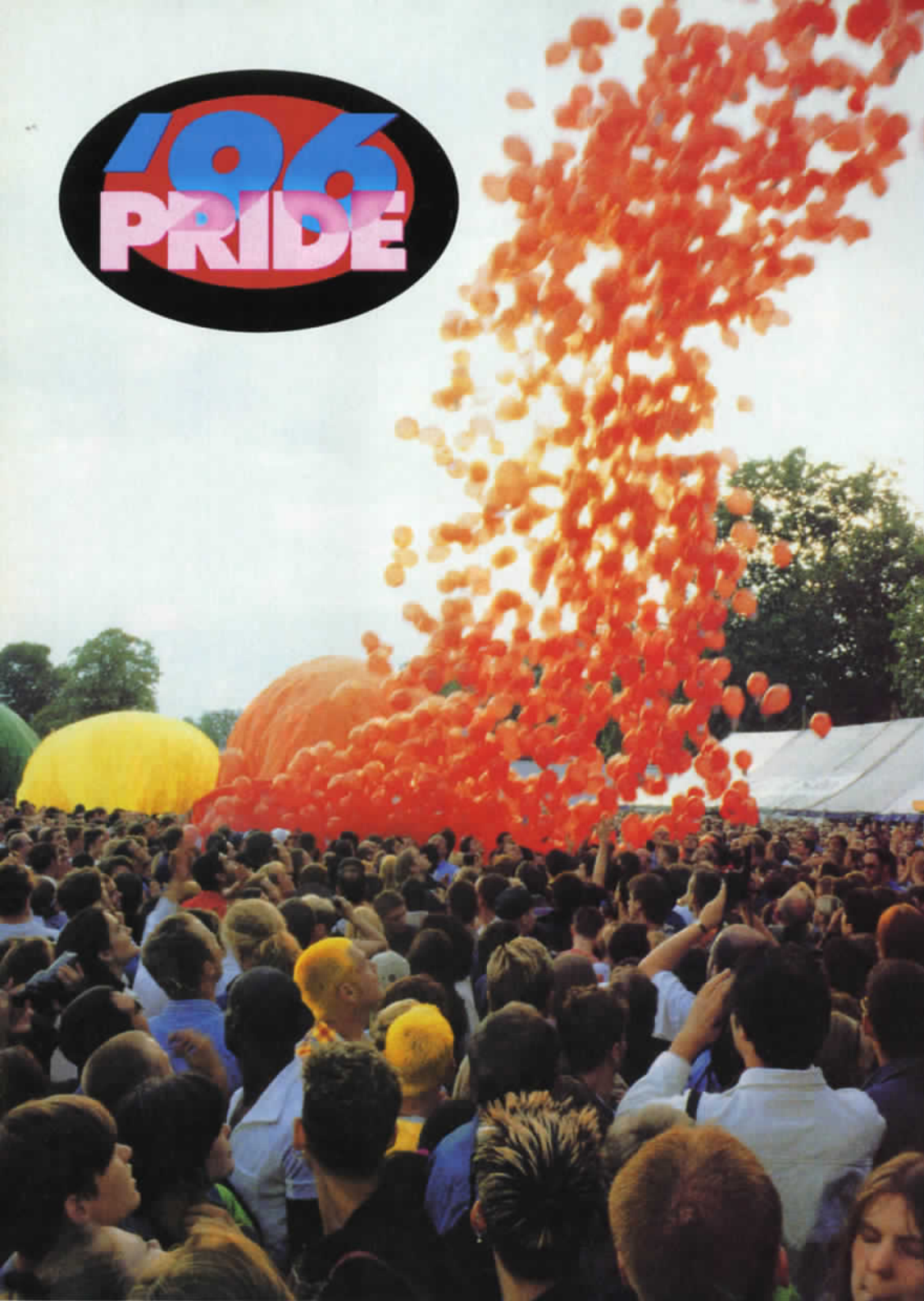
NOW IN their silver jubilee 25th year, Britain's annual Pride celebrations took place in London on July 6th. Enjoying unexpectedly sunny weather, an estimated 70,000 people joined the midday march through the centre of the city, and an officially counted 160,000 later attended the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender Pride festival on Clapham Common. Veterans from the early 1970s Gay Liberation Front alongside gay and lesbian youth groups led the march, in tune with the theme of "Generations of activism". At the festival, alongside the market stalls, dance and entertainment tents, community group marquees and the funfair, the main stage saw appearances by Boy George, Jimmy Somerville, Julian Clary, Kylie Minogue, Gabrielle, the Shamen and Bjorn Again.

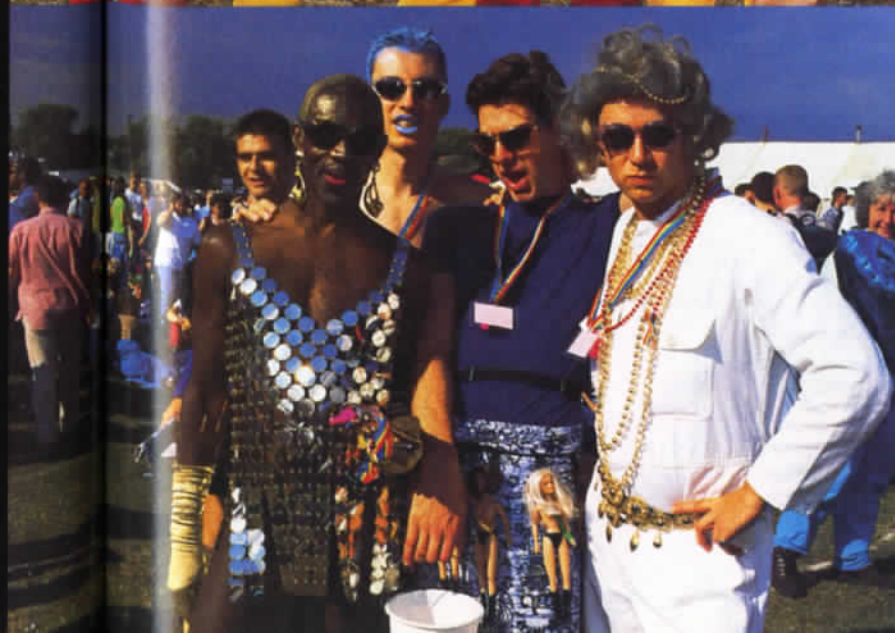
