GAY PRIDE WEEK 1978

GAY PRIDE 78 is a ten day festival from June 30th-July9th organised by and for gay people, celebrating our gay identity.

The past year has seen an increase in the number of attacks on gay people: the successful prosecution of Gay News and its subsequent banning by WHSmith; the vicious assaults on lesbians by the Evening News and Daily Expressand the attack on the Royal Vauxhall Tavern by members of the National Front. Yet again gay people have been sacked, beaten up and murdered and police harassment of gay people has been stepped up.

This year, however, has seen a revitalising of the gay movement: the formation of the National Gay News Defence Committee which organised the largest ever gay demonstration outside America and the birth of the Gay Activists' Alliance, a new, nationwide organisation committed to responding to attacks on gay people.

The aim of Gay Pride 78 is to show the positive side of being gay: GAY IS FUN; GAY IS PROUD; GAY IS BEAUTIFUL! We have organised a "Week" of discos, exhibitions, theatre, workshops etc, climaxing with a Carnival Parade and March through West London on July 8th.
