



Children's Letters & Presents Step by Step Guide

We've created a simple process for the children's letters and presents to make your visit with Santa extra magical.

Please follow these simple steps:

- 1** Please ask the children to write a letter to Santa that mentions some items from their wish list. Now pretend that you have posted it to Lapland.
- 2** Buy one of the small items listed, this is going to be the gift they receive from Santa. On your confirmation invoice, you will see a reduction (Gift Allowance) of £15/€25 has been applied to each child's tour cost for this reason.
- 3** Wrap and label the gift with your child's full name e.g. *'Emily Smith, love from Santa'*, and carefully attach their letter to the item.
- 4** Write your Booking Reference, Lead Name and Coach Letter on something like a Post-it note and attach it to the gift. You will find your Coach details on your final itinerary.
- 5** Pack the wrapped presents in your suitcases, they cannot be carried as hand luggage!
- 6** On arrival evening, before dinner, one of the adults should deliver the 'extra items' (present) to the 'Item Collection' point (your guide will tell you where this is) and an elf will issue a receipt.

We assure you that this whole process is very discreet.

Please try not to spend too much more than £15/€25, it's important that Santa is seen to treat all the children the same.

By following our guidelines, Santa will have the children's letters when you meet him and he will be able to refer to them during conversation. You might like to highlight any pets or special friends mentioned in the letter (no 3D stickers please) and if Santa has the opportunity, he will try to mention them to make this an even more magical experience.
