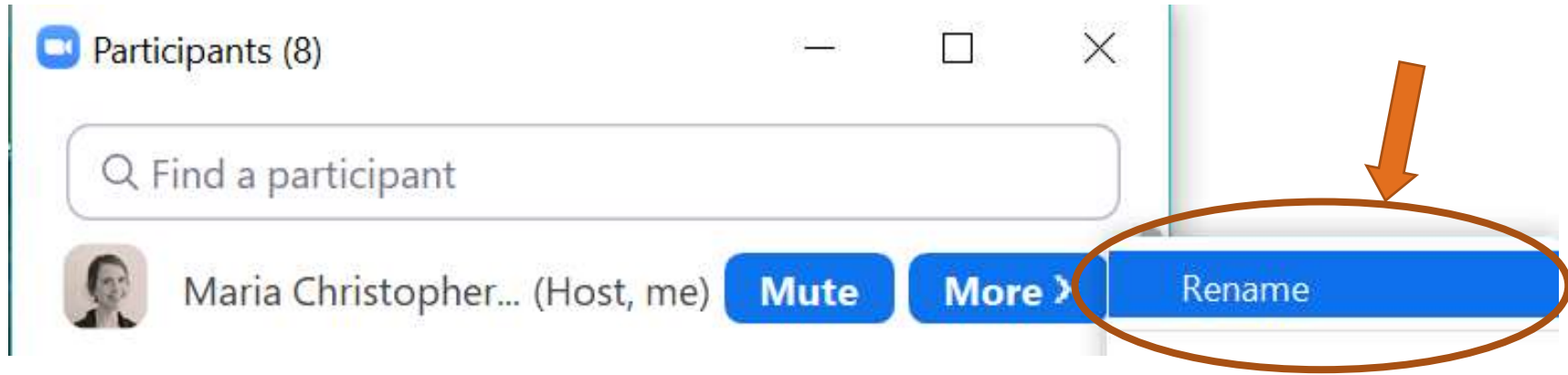




# **GEWEP III annual meeting 2020**

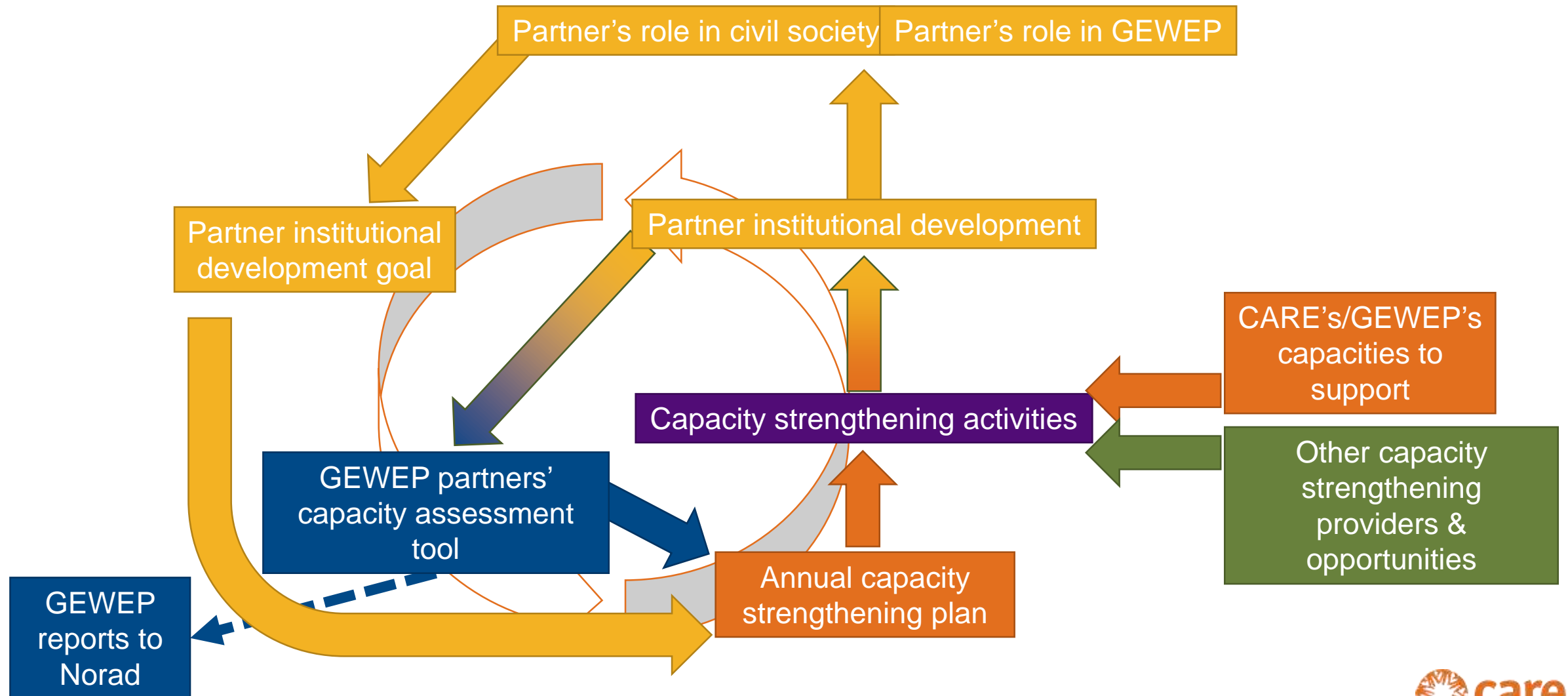
# Building blocks of GEWEP partners strengthening



# GEWEP Partners' Institutional Development Goals

- Should describe where each partner wants to be (in ~5 years), as a civil society organization
  - Which **position** the partner want to have in the civil society?
  - What **roles** the partner wants to play?
  - Which **profile** the partner wants to develop and be recognized for?
- Examples of possible formulation (no format required: it is *your* goal!)
  - ✓ By 2025, [ORGANIZATION X] will be recognized by key stakeholders in [COUNTRY Y] and donors as the leader in [THEMATIC AREA Z]...
  - ✓ By 2025, [X] will be the representative of the voice and interests of [SOCIAL GROUP Y] in [POLICY PROCESS Z]...
  - ✓ By 2025, [X] will be the key [THEMATIC AREA W] service provider of to [SOCIAL GROUP Y] in [GEOGRAPHIC AREA Z]...

# GEWEP partner capacity assessment tool

- A tool to design and monitor a program component
- Participatory discussion process
- Quantitative = scores (relative)
- Qualitative = findings and recommendations
- Basis for development plans
- Consolidated scores and key findings in report to Norad
- Annual update + midterm/endline

# Capacity Strengthening Plan

- Developed in a **participatory way**, based on recommendations from assessment, including prioritization based on institutional development goal
- **No specific format**, but should clarify for each partner:
  - What are the **prioritized areas** of development – objectives – and **why**?
  - What are the capacity development **activities** to be implemented and **when**?
  - Which **resources** (funds, people, tools, etc.) and which **methods** (trainings, purchase, etc.) will be used for these activities?
- **Best practice:** used to monitor activities, outputs and results during next assessment cycle for
  - learning,
  - adaptation
  - and accountability purposes

# What has been reported during GEWEP II?

- **Funding:** access to stable multi-year funding (Norad) which can trigger access to other donors
- **Visibility** towards national stakeholders (incl. authorities, private sector, INGOs) as expert CSOs, leading to new partnerships
- **Capacity** strengthening on key areas: financial management, gender programming, MEAL, internal governance and policies, advocacy, context analysis, etc.
- **Learning:** opportunities for sharing experience and skills with other CSOs involved in GEWEP
- **Equipment** donation (ITC, software, vehicles, etc.)

# Which dimensions of CARE's/GEWEP's support are most important for your organization and for which you would like to assess CARE??

Partners' group work (20 minutes)

1. Individual reflection time 5 minutes (pre-meeting assignment)
2. All partner participants connect to country zoom breakout room (CARE Norway staff assisting in each room at start)

  - Remember: your focus is on the methodology (how / which tool we use) and NOT on the dimensions to be included in this assessment
