Timelines- Leading to Accelerated Transition



Key messages



The transition of the CCCM Cluster was **already envisioned as part of the Cluster 2025 strategy.**



The number of IDPs in sites dropped significantly—from approximately 500,000 people across 7,000 sites in 2022 to roughly 70,000 people in 1,500 sites by early 2025.



The decision to accelerate the transition is **driven by the Humanitarian RESET initiative and Ukraine HCT Clusters fit-for-purpose review.**





Key messages



Transferring select Cluster functions and tools to **government** authorities where capacity and willingness exist.



Merging key functions and platforms with the **Protection** and **Shelter Clusters**, where national systems are not yet able to fully absorb responsibilities



Strengthening localization and collaboration with recovery actors where feasible to address systemic barriers and support sustainable solutions (**e.g. collaboration with RCC**)



CCCM expertise is staying within the future Protection Cluster Team.



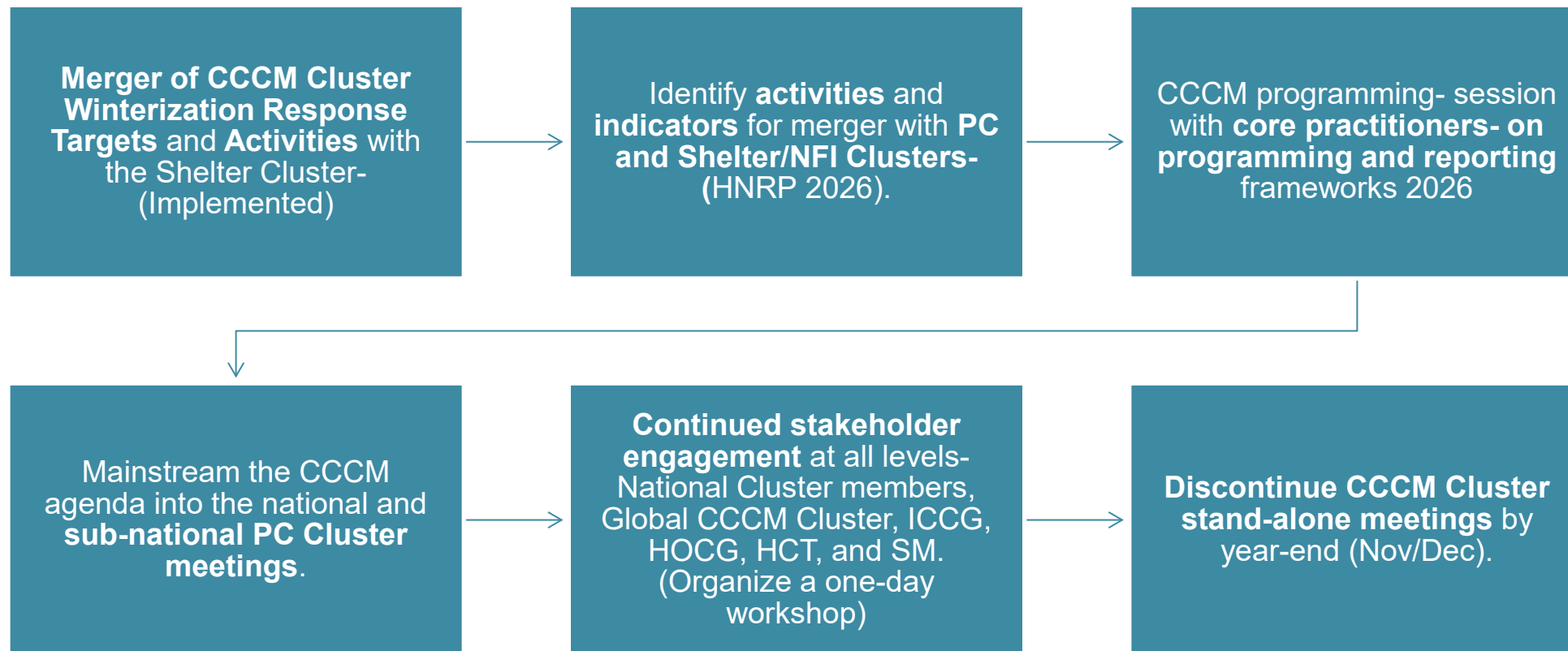
Coord Tools for Handover



| Tools | Handover to | Next Action Points |

| Collective Site Monitoring | Retain within the Protection Cluster , Implemented by REACH under UNHCR Partnership with Acted | Review CSM Survey |
| Evacuation Tracker in Transit Centres | Handover to RCC | Initiate discussions with RCC and extend Cluster IM support thro the transition |
| Master List of Collective Sites | Handover to MinDev/ MoSP | Initiate discussions with MinDev/MoSP and extend Cluster IM support thro the transition |
| New Displacement in Collective Sites | Implement through Protection Cluster partners (2026) | IM/PC Cluster continued support |
