Overview

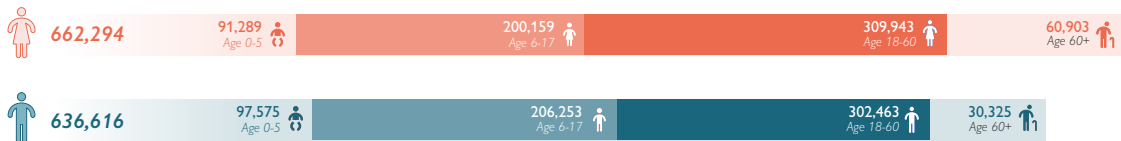
On 3 February 2025, the Site Management Cluster (SMC), through its partners, launched a site verification exercise across the Gaza Strip. Some 160 field staff were trained on the tool, which was developed with Clusters' sectoral inputs. The exercise has two core objectives: to verify the existence and current status of all previously recorded displacement sites in order to update the 2026 site list, and to collect a minimum essential dataset at the site level to inform and support the coordinated humanitarian response. Coverage includes all accessible neighborhoods west of the "yellow line", with teams conducting site visits to confirm site status (active, inactive, or not found), identify sites that are newly established or not previously recorded by SMC, and record site conditions and service gaps.

Data Limitations

The assessment is currently ongoing. The data presented reflects a snapshot of information collected as of 10 March and does not yet constitute a comprehensive overview of all displacement sites across Gaza. All figures remain subject to review, validation, data cleaning, and subsequent updates. Notably, the total number of assessments conducted exceeds the number of active sites identified, as approximately 18% of previously recorded sites were confirmed to no longer host displaced populations.



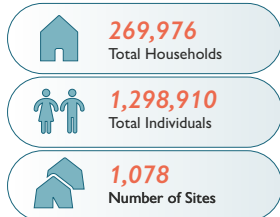

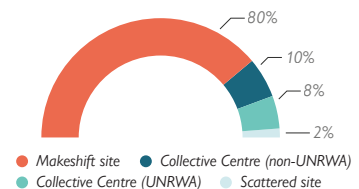
REPORTED VULNERABILITIES AT SITE LEVEL

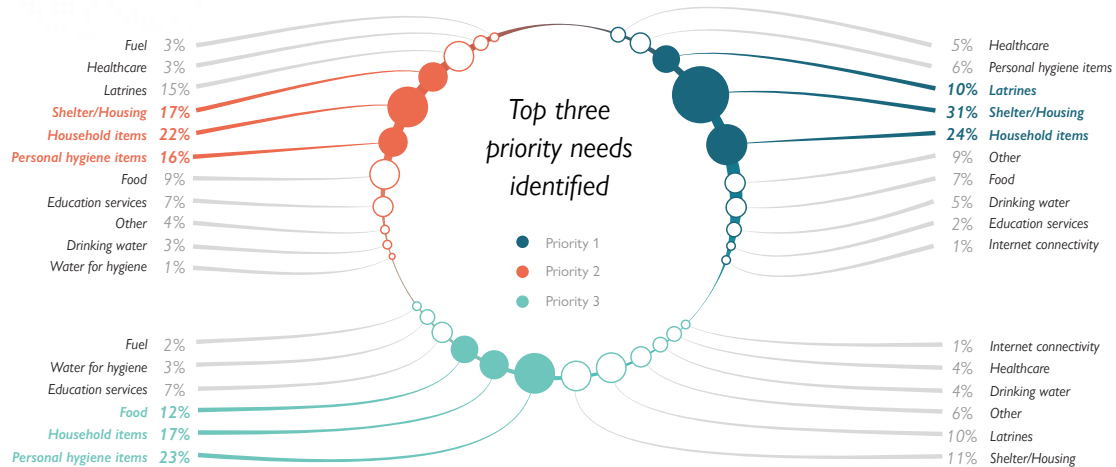


TOTAL POPULATION

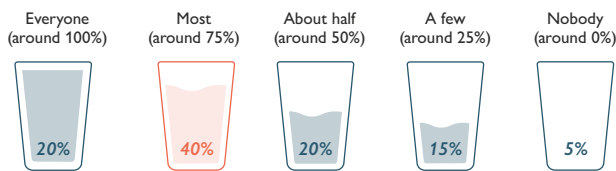


SITE TYPOLOGY



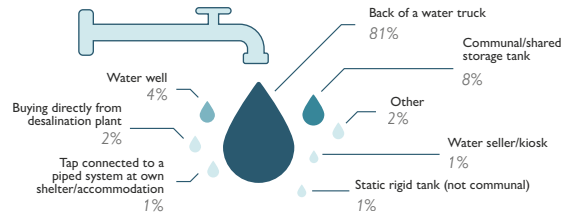


% OF SITE RESIDENTS WITH ENOUGH WATER FOR DRINKING AND COOKING IN THE PAST 30 DAYS

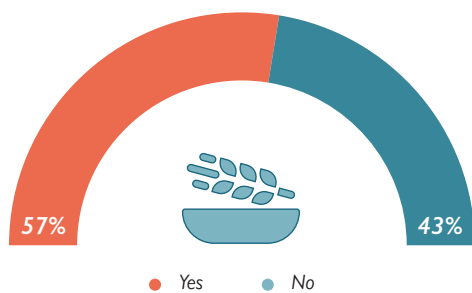

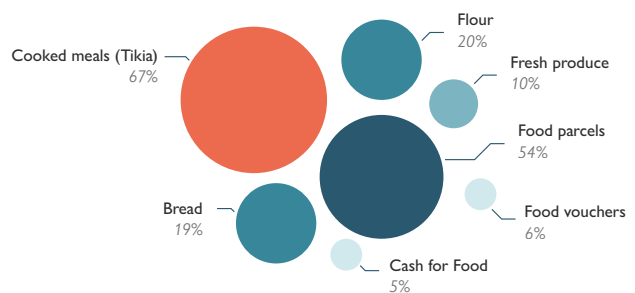
WHAT IS THE PRIMARY WATER DISTRIBUTION POINT?



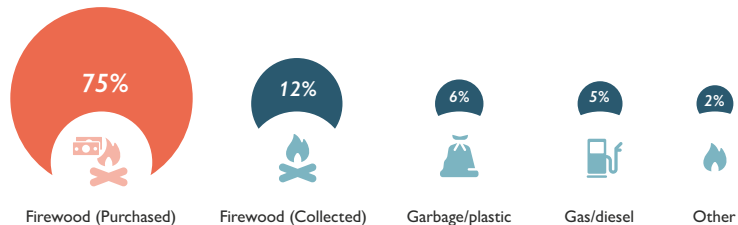
DID THE SITE RECEIVE ANY FOOD ASSISTANCE IN THE LAST 30 DAYS?

MAIN ENERGY SOURCE FOR COOKING

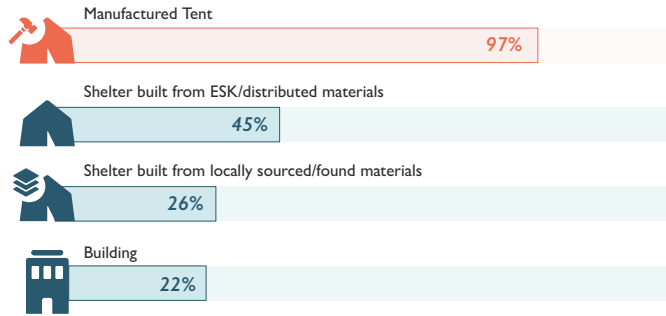


WHAT IS THE MAIN SOURCE OF FOOD FOR PEOPLE IN THE SITE?



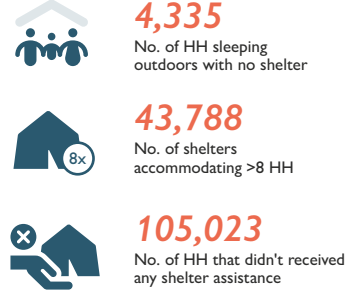


WHAT TYPES OF SHELTERS ARE PRESENT IN THE SITE?

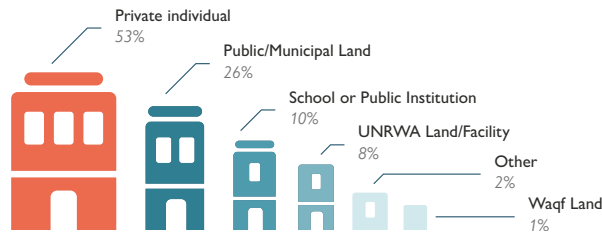
SHELTER GAPS AND OVERCROWDING

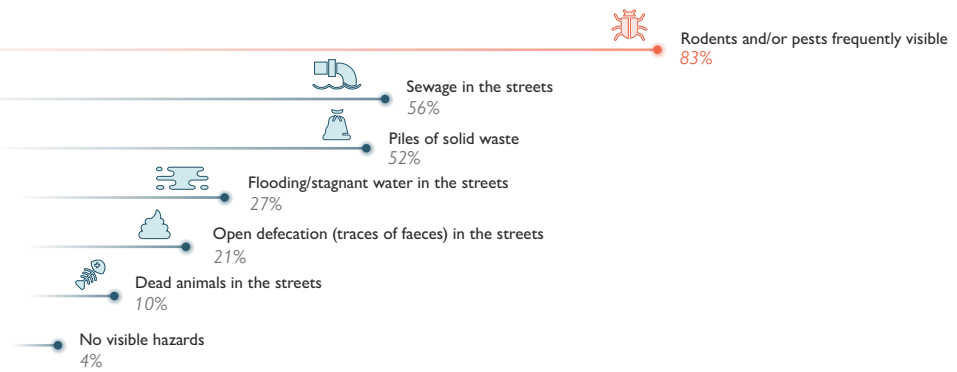
WHAT TYPE OF LAND OWNERSHIP IS THE SITE LOCATED ON?
