Pre-sessional English

The Pre-sessional English course provides a short and intensive preparation in English language and study skills for students who are due to start an undergraduate or postgraduate degree at the University of East Anglia in September 2021.

Age requirement

17 years and above

Academic entry requirements

You must hold an offer of a place on a degree programme at UEA.

English language entry requirements

Only an official IELTS or other secure English language test (SELT) will be accepted as proof of English language proficiency.

10 week: a maximum of one IELTS band lower than the level required by your University School of Study, both overall and in subskills.

6 week: a maximum of 0.5 IELTS lower than the level required by your University School of Study, both overall and in subskills.

4 week: the same IELTS point band as the level required by your University School of Study, with 0.5 IELTS band lower in one subskill.

Please ensure you consult your University School of Study for details of the English language level (both overall and for specific skills) required for entry onto your chosen course.

* Please note that lessons are one hour including an allowance for class changeover. Lessons comprise taught classes, tutorials and lectures.

What if I've already been accepted by UEA?

While IELTS exams provide a good indication of your general English level, they do not include assessment of specific academic, degree-level study skills. The four-week Pre-sessional English course will develop these skills, giving you confidence in reading, writing, speaking, listening and research skills at university level.

Assessment

You will be assessed to determine whether you have met the University's English requirements before progressing to your degree programme. Methods of assessment include:

- written texts
- extended essays
- listening tests
- presentations
- portfolio work

Arrival

You should plan to arrive the Saturday or Sunday before the course start date. Late arrival may affect your chances of progressing to the University.



What documents do I need to include?

- Completed application form, signed by the student or the parent/legal guardian.
- A copy of your university offer letter.
- Copy(ies) of English language certificate(s) in English.
- Full details of previous study in the UK.
- A copy of your passport.

What happens next?

After carefully reviewing your application, if successful, we will send you a formal offer of a place. For complete applications, this is usually within two working days.

Once we have received your tuition fee and accommodation deposit (as detailed in the offer letter) and all the conditions of your offer have been met, we will confirm your place. We will send your Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS), which you will need to apply for a Student visa, no earlier than 3 months before the course start date.
