Minimum admission requirements vary by program, but most CapU programs require successful completion of the following:

- 1 B.C. secondary school (Grade 12) or equivalent (B.C. Adult Dogwood Graduation Diploma or General Education Diploma).
- 2 A minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 (60%) calculated on English Studies 12 or English 12 or English First Peoples 12 and two academic Grade 12 courses. See the list of accepted Grade 12 courses: capilanou.ca/accepted-courses
- 3 We want you to be part of our community, so if you don't meet the academic requirements or need to boost your high school grades before applying, we can help. Visit capilanou.ca/upgrading

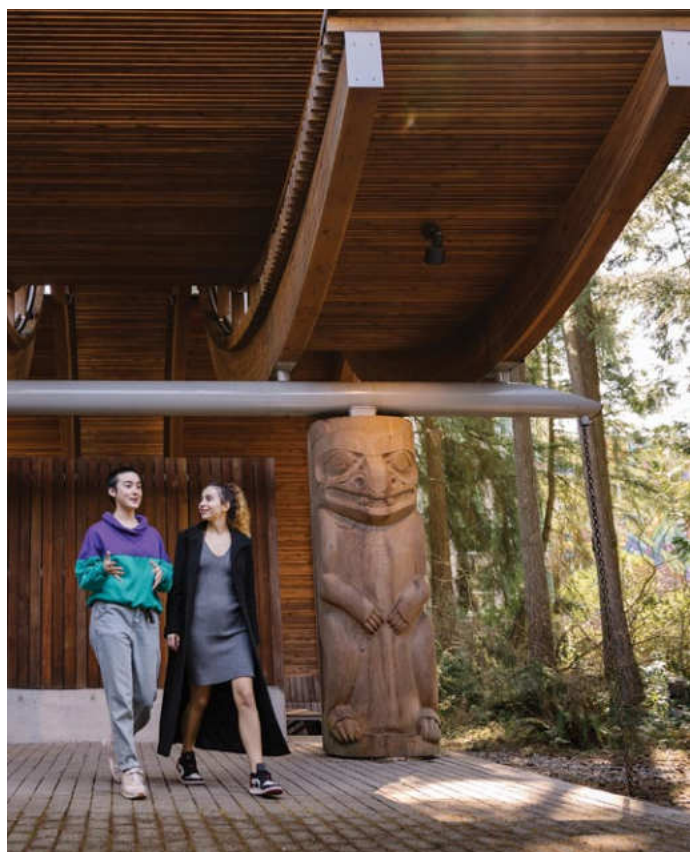
