Working in Canada

Full-time students can work off-campus up to 20 hours a week when attending school and full-time during scheduled breaks. EAP students are not allowed to work off-campus. You may apply for a post-graduation work permit (PGWP) to work in Canada for up to three years, depending on the duration of your study.

On-campus residence (2022/23) - Falcon House, Peregrine House, Merlin House (apartment-style)

September to April: \$9,500 including \$1,200 mandatory meal plan (A light meal plan to allow the student occasional meals at the Fanshawe College outlets.

Over 8 months it works out to only \$37.50/week).

Residence (2022/23) - Kestrel Court (townhouse, beside the London campus) September to April: \$7,750 for standard bedroom; 7,500 for smaller bedroom. Meal plan is not required, but may be purchased.
