

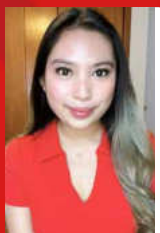

Fanshawe College is a large public college with its main campus in London, Ontario, Canada, which is located two hours from Niagara Falls or Toronto. Other Fanshawe campuses include London South and London Downtown, as well as regional locations in St. Thomas, Simcoe, Woodstock and downtown Toronto.

There are approximately 21,000 full-time students at Fanshawe, including 7,500 international students from 100+ countries. Today, there are more than 200,000 Fanshawe alumni making a difference around the world.

Fanshawe offers 220+ academic programs, ranging from English for Academic Purposes (EAP) to diplomas, advanced diplomas, post-graduate certificates and honours bachelor degrees. Students who want to “earn while they learn” can take one of 60 different co-operative (co-op) programs offered.

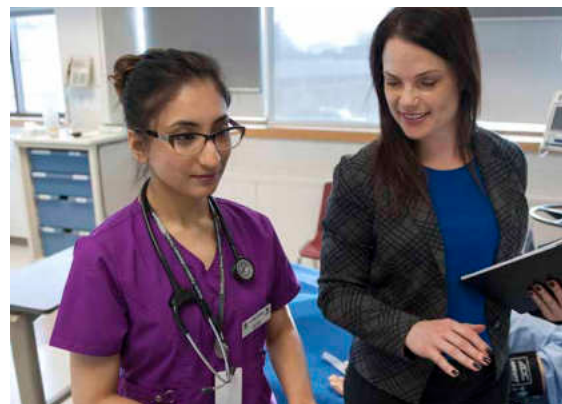

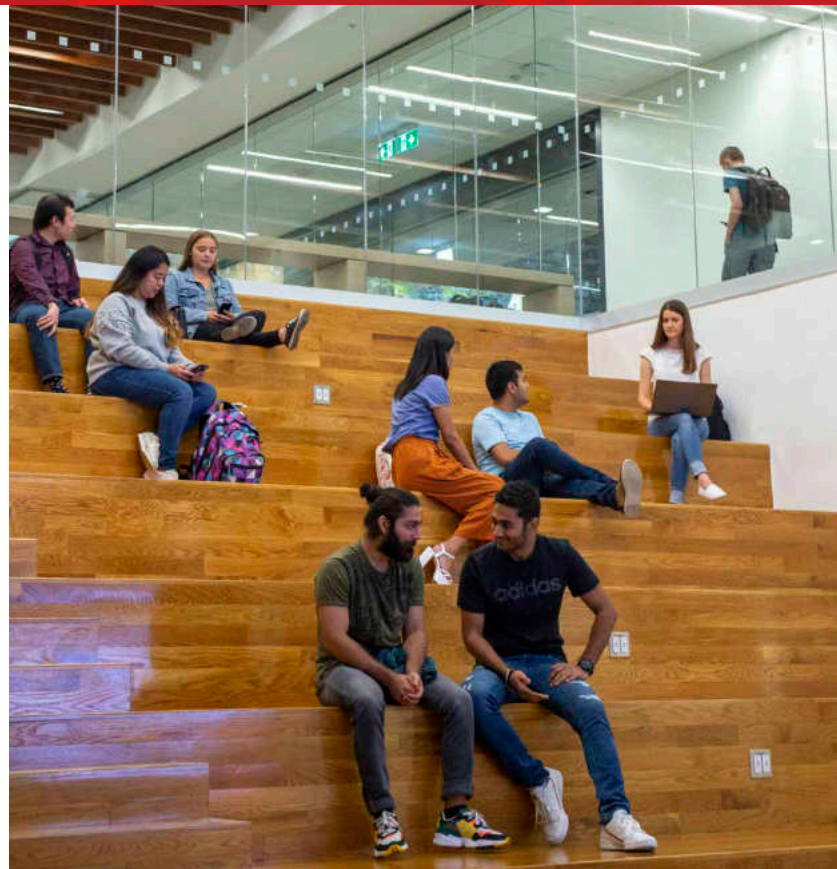

FANSHAWE CAMPUSES

Campuses in London and other locations!



Norton Wolf School of Aviation and Aerospace Technology is located at the London Airport, just a few minutes from the main Oxford Street campus. This \$10-million hangar facility is 80,000 square-feet and features a Boeing 727, DHC-7, Dassault Falcon 10 and Hawker HS125, corporate jets, as well as other fixed wing aircraft and helicopters.



School of Transportation Technology is located approximately one-block away from Fanshawe's main campus. It's a 148,000 square-foot facility that accommodates students seeking job-ready credentials in the transportation industry. The building features state-of-the-art equipment and learning tools, as well as sustainable elements.



London Downtown Campus is located in the heart of downtown London on Dundas Street (20 minutes from main campus). Two buildings are home to the School of Digital & Performing Arts and the School of Tourism, Hospitality & Culinary Arts. More than 2,000 staff and students are based downtown utilizing state-of-the-art equipment including the Chef's Table restaurant.



London South Campus is located at 1060 Wellington Road in south London. This campus is ideal for student needs, offering on-site parking, easy access to public transit, affordable housing and many options for shopping and food.



The **Simcoe/Norfolk Regional Campus** provides a college experience that is a mix of small town charm, friendliness, and the education you need. The campus has been renovated with new classrooms, computers, a state-of-the-art welding facility and SMART technology in all classrooms.



The **Woodstock/Oxford Regional Campus** is part of the Woodstock Community Complex, which also houses the Goff Community Hall, a gymnastics centre, two arenas, a figure skating club and food services. Woodstock is a city of 38,000 with manufacturing, agriculture and parks and recreation.



The **St. Thomas/Elgin Regional Campus** is located about a 40 minute drive from the London campus and has a full service cafeteria, library and resource centre. St. Thomas is famous for its railroad history and is surrounded by quaint towns and villages.



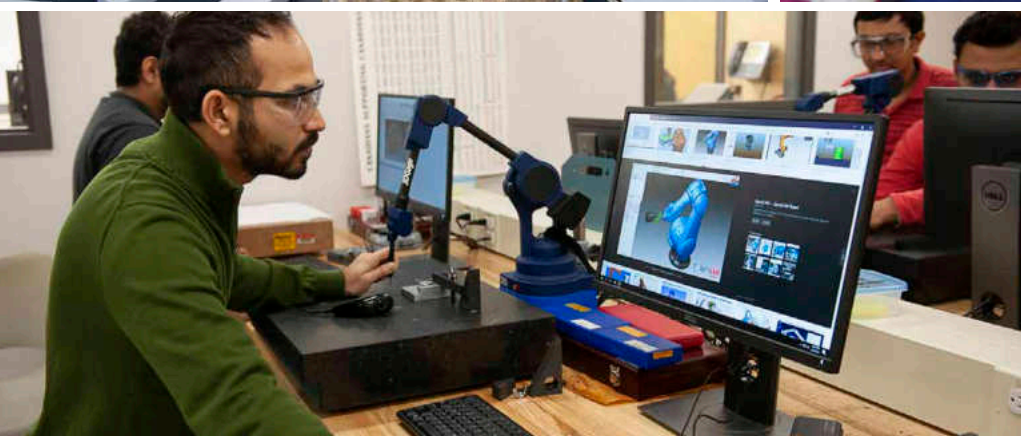

Working in Canada

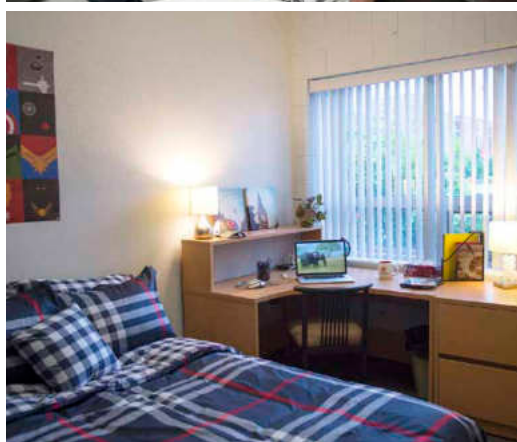
Full-time students can work off-campus up to 20 hours a week when attending school and full-time during scheduled breaks. EAP students are not allowed to work off-campus. You may apply for a post-graduation work permit (PGWP) to work in Canada for up to three years, depending on the duration of your study.

On-campus residence (2022/23) - Falcon House, Peregrine House, Merlin House (apartment-style)

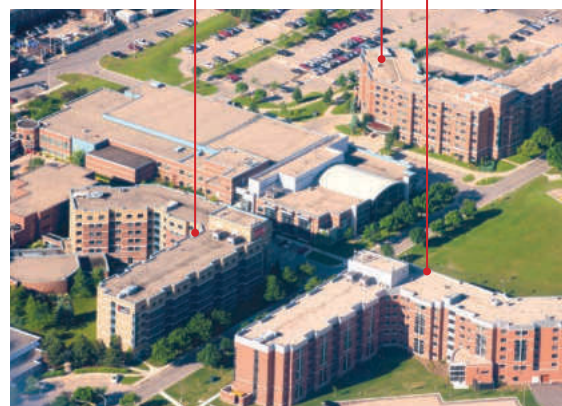
September to April: \$9,500 including \$1,200 mandatory meal plan (A light meal plan to allow the student occasional meals at the Fanshawe College outlets. Over 8 months it works out to only \$37.50/week).

Residence (2022/23) - Kestrel Court (townhouse, beside the London campus) September to April: \$7,750 for standard bedroom; 7,500 for smaller bedroom. Meal plan is not required, but may be purchased.

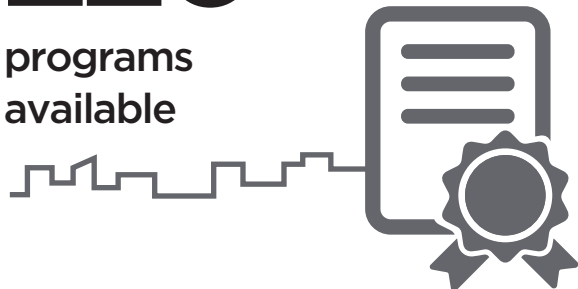

International students applying through the SDS Program (Student Direct Stream) from Antigua and Barbuda, Brazil, China, Colombia, Costa Rica, India, Morocco, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines, Senegal, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, Vietnam should note that the SDS IELTS requirements are 6.0 with no score less than 6.0 in any of the four bands. For programs listing a higher IELTS requirement, the higher score will be required. Please note: There may be additional country-specific requirements.

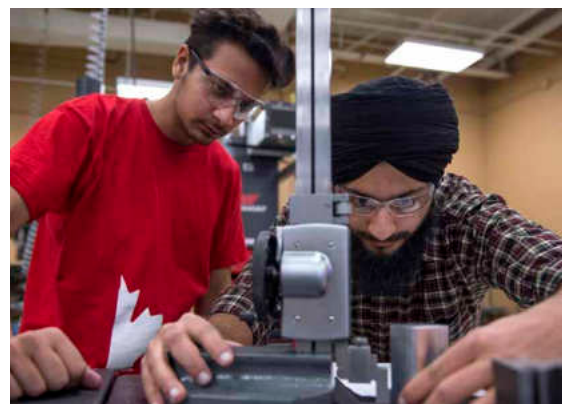

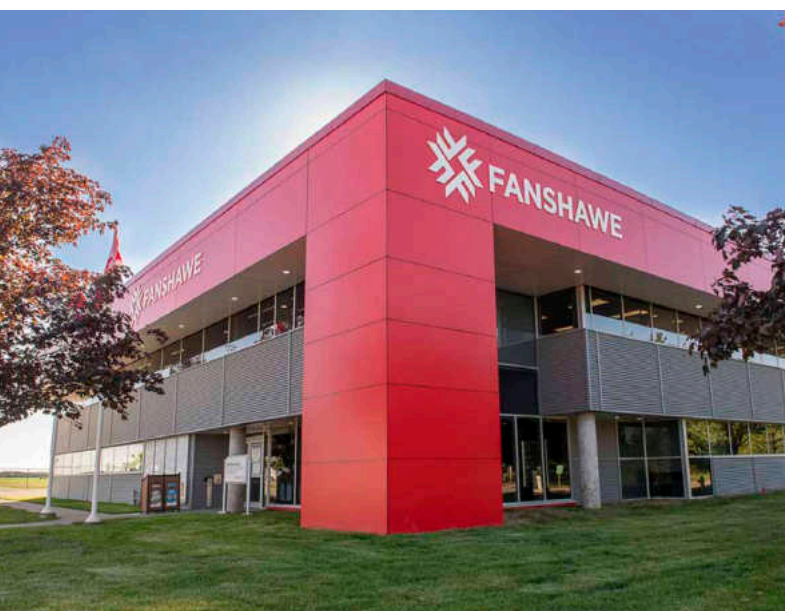
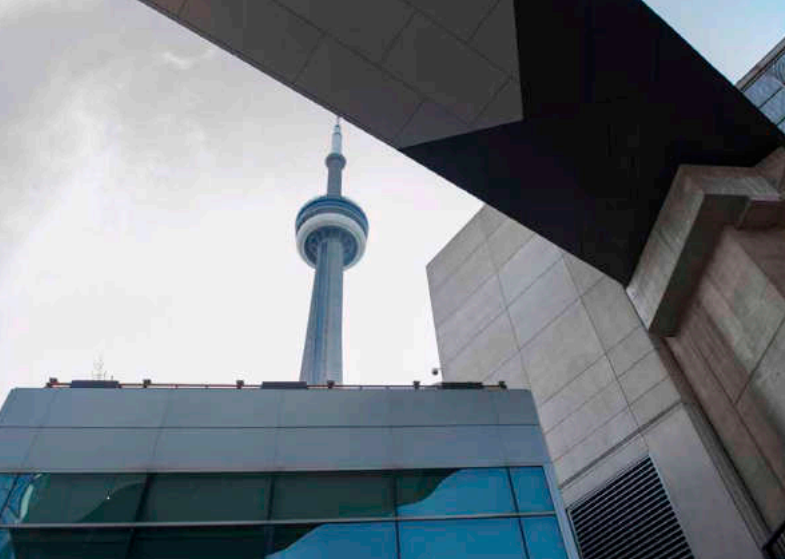
