In order to achieve formative goals, the Medicine and Surgery programme is organised to offer a total number of 360 European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), spread over a 6-year course. 60 credits consist of activities aimed at acquiring specific professional skills. Each ECTS corresponds to 12 hours of teaching. In case of professional training, each credit corresponds to 17 hours.

CAREER PATHS

- Università Cattolica's MD is valid academically in all of the EU and many other countries for residency study or professional activity (students need to monitor local regulations for getting a license to practice)
- The programme is designed for students who wish to become qualified medical practitioners. A various range of careers are open to medical graduates. Due to the innovative curriculum, students will be able to start a career in both basic and clinical scientific research.

Admission information - general requirements

High School Diploma

The candidate's high school qualification has to:

- Be conferred after min. 12 years of previous global schooling
- Satisfy the requirements for access to university in the awarding country

If, in the candidate's home country, admission to university-level studies is subject to a special exam (e.g. ENEM/ Vestibular in Brazil, TYT and AYT in Turkey, Gaokao in China, etc.), students must give evidence to have passed such selection with the required scores.

Applicants are not required to have any specific science subjects or grades, but are strongly advised to refer to the "List of topics to study for the scientific questions" document on the website to prepare adequately for the entrance exam.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

ENTRANCE EXAM

Admission to the 6-year MD in Medicine and Surgery is subject to the applicant's performance and subsequent ranking in Università Cattolica's very own entrance exam.

The programme has a maximum capacity of 80 places divided as follows:

- 30 seats reserved to Italian and EU citizens residing anywhere and non-EU citizens legally residing in Italy with permesso di soggiorno/residence permit
- 50 seats reserved to non-EU citizens residing abroad

In the case of students with double nationality, if one is of an EU country, it will prevail for the purpose of the final ranking of the Competition Call (art. 19, comma 2, of L n. 218/1995).

EU ranking: The Entrance Exam will be held in person at suitable test centres in Italy and abroad in multisession mode

Non-EU ranking: The Entrance Exam will be administered remotely with the use of a proctoring system, allowing candidates to take the exam from home

Choose your programme and apply online (Link available as soon as applications open) international unicattit)



Create an account



Fill out the online application form



Upload the following documents:

- Copy of your passport/s
- Official High School transcripts (accepted in English or Italian). Please scan these as one document only
- If already graduated, High School Diploma
- Evidence of language proficiency, where needed (if already available)



Submit application



Pay the €160 application fee to start the evaluation procedure

After submission, Università Cattolica's International Admissions Office will evaluate eligibility to access the Entrance exam.

Only candidates whose eligibility has been confirmed will be officially assigned to one of the applicant rankings (EU or non-EU).

TUITION FEES AND FINANCIAL AID

Tuition fees do not depend on students' citizenship but on where they pay taxes.

The yearly tuition fee is divided in five different instalments: the first instalment of \leq 4,000 will be considered as a deposit to confirm the spot in the programme.

Fees may be subject to variations.
