NSS (THE NATIONAL STUDENT SURVEY 2020):

The 2020 National Student Survey (NSS), published by Texunatech on behalf of the Office for Students, surveyed over 310,000 students in the UK about their university experience. Students were asked about a variety of factors, including the teaching on their courses, learning opportunities and resources, academic support and feedback, the university community, their students' union and student representation, along with their overall satisfaction with the quality of their course.



How to Apply

Step 1: Initial Consultation (IAG)

From choosing your desired course, writing your personal statement and submitting the application, you can count on our friendly Recruitment Team for help and guidance at every step of the way. Get in touch to make an initial appointment to discuss your situation.

Step 2: Submit your application

- For a few courses, you will need to complete a PDF/MS Online application form;
- For most courses, you will need to submit an online application via UCAS (or other portals).

Our recruitment team will help you navigate this process and complete your application UCAS applications cost £20 for one course choice or £25 for multiple course choices.

Step 3: English Language Requirements

- If you don't have a qualification which demonstrates the required level of English proficiency you will need to take our English language screening assessment. This supervised assessment will test your reading, writing, listening and speaking skills. The initial English assessment takes around 90 minutes to complete;
- For other courses you may need to attend pre-sessional classes and sit a final English test;
- If you hold an accepted English qualification you will be exempt from this step.
