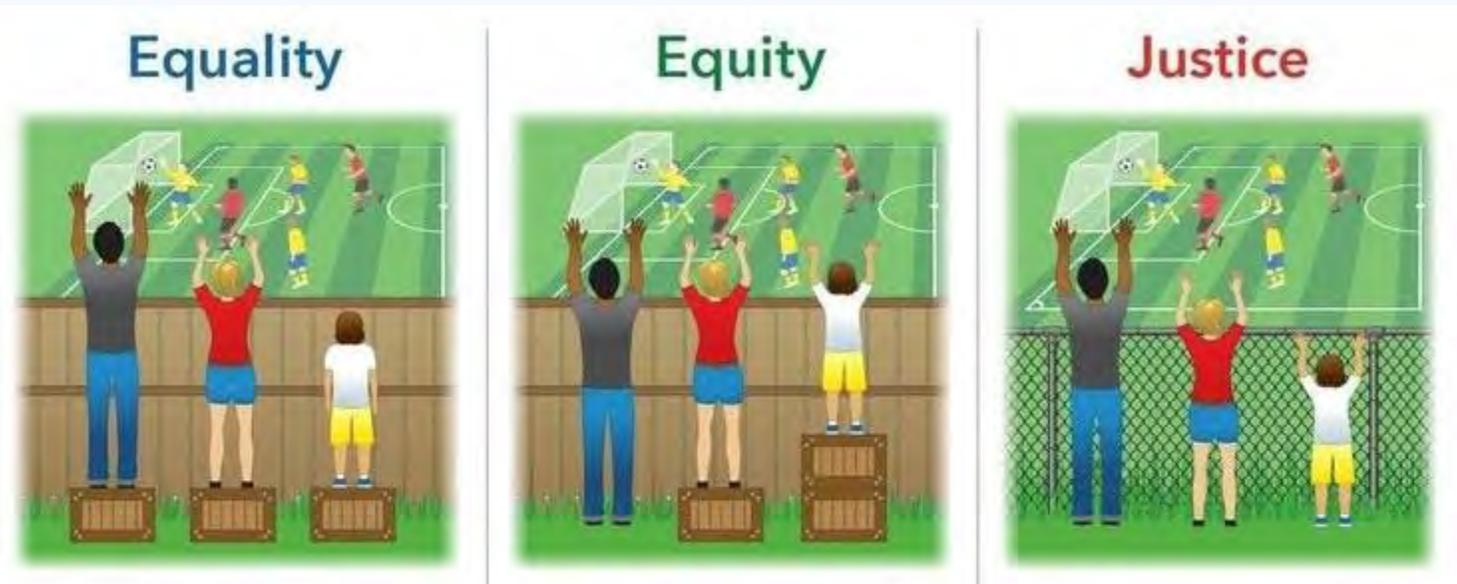

Promotion

Involves systemic change, catalysing changes at deepest level of beliefs, assumptions and values as well as behaviour and structures
