- An inner courtyard with two patio areas, with flower beds for keen gardeners to plant and maintain.
- A Dementia House with a private garden and assistive technology, including a SMART TV for reminiscence activities, dementia friendly signage, adaptive lighting and a call bell system with passive infrared sensors.
- The Home hosts regular activities, such as arts and craft classes, games, cooking and baking sessions, and has its very own pub: Cadogan Arms.
- Its minibus supports residents to stay connected with their communities, from trips to the beach and the city centre to beautiful places of interest.
