seedlings, or admiring a blooming flower, we will create wonderful learning experiences through play and discovery. We can't wait to see our little gardeners in action as they nurture their plants



math skills. The Butterfly book of the month will be "The Tiny Seed" by Eric Carle


The Butterfly Room will be Planting Seeds such as beans and herbs in small pots. They can water them and watch them grow over time!

necklaces and bracelets, these are a choking hazard if they break on the premises.


