

A+bility Limited supports vulnerable adults:

- to live in their own home, to engage in activities and to develop independent living skills.
- By providing a supported living service

We also provide support for children and young people who may be:

- In foster care
- Learning disabled/autistic
- Physically disabled
- Experiencing social, emotional and behavioural difficulties
- Excluded from mainstream school

The support we carry out may include:

- Mentoring
- Support at home
- Support to access the community
- Activities
- Independence and life skills.

Staff work alone or in pairs and are supported by a team that includes social workers and qualified managers.

A+bility Limited has a sister company that provides supported accommodation for care leavers, from the age of 16, working towards independence.
