About Us

Thurrock's Social Prescribing programme supports people with their health and wellbeing needs, including chronic conditions.

Social prescribing is open to patients aged 18+ who present to their GP with issues that have a non - clinical underlying cause. Patients may have a social need, on-going health conditions, regularly attend their GP surgery or are at risk of unplanned admission.

Social Prescribing Navigators meet patients referred by their GP at their practice before referring and signposting to appropriate services.

Patients are treated holistically with the point of referral determined by individual need; this could include information to support health, finance or social isolation.

Navigators allocate up to one hour with each patient and arrange a follow-up contact to track progress. Navigators will update GPs on the patient's progress and referral pathways before discharge.
