# Dropping off and collecting children—main site



With the lifting of restrictions, parents and carers can now come up to the KS1 hall when dropping off or collecting their children at Superkids.

When you arrive at the school gate, please press the Superkids buzzer and stand in-front of the camera so we can identify you. Please state your child's name. We will then buzz open the gate. Please walk up the metal stairs in the KS1 playground and enter the building / corridor. Turn right. The KS1 hall is at the top of the short flight of steps.

Please wait at the bottom of the KS1 hall stairs to collect your child. For safeguarding, please note that children will not be released from the hall unless we can see the parent/carer.

During the afternoon, our team games in the KS2 sports hall are very popular. However, please wait at the designated area in KS1, and your child will come to you. Younger children will be escorted from the KS2 hall by a Superkids staff member.

# **Safeguarding Reminders**

**Phone Policy**—please ensure mobile phones and devices with cameras are out of sight (in your bag or pocket) whilst you are waiting in the school corridor or in the playground when the children are playing outside. This is to safeguard all our children from unauthorised images.

**Notifying Superkids when your child is not attending -**please inform Superkids via text by 2.45pm if you are collecting your child directly from their class, or if your child is not attending a session. This includes when your child has been absent from school due to illness.

**If you are running late** - please send a text ASAP if your child will be collected **after 6pm (5.45pm Early Years)**. A late charge of £1 per minute after 6pm is added to your invoice in all cases and persistent lateness (3 times of more) may result in the loss of your after-school place.

Please note that Superkids are required to vacate the school promptly so that the site can be secured and locked.

## **Breakfast Club Times**

Whilst spending time at the breakfast club, I noticed that quite a few children arrive around or after 8.30am, many of which are in Reception class. This leads to a late rush of breakfast orders and children eating hurriedly before the school day starts.



To address this, from 21st February Superkids breakfast will be served up to 8.20am. Please ensure that your child arrives by 8.20am if they require breakfast.

This provides time for breakfast to be prepared for your child and for your child to eat, play and be ready for their day at school.

Please note that younger children, in particular, usually require more time to eat their breakfast. So to ensure your child's morning is not rushed, please drop them off to Superkids in good time.
