Eucharistic Adoration: Holy Cross Priory Sunday evening 5.30 – 6.30pm.

Cardinal Vincent Nichols, President of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England & Wales, has released a statement assuring the Jewish community of his prayers after the terror attack on the Heaton Park Hebrew Congregation Synagogue in Manchester on Thursday.

"The killing of two Jewish worshippers, the injuries inflicted on others, & the attempt to drive a car into a crowd in Manchester are expressions of utter hatred that must not be tolerated in this land. That such an attack is directed at the Jewish community, & on Yom Kippur, this most solemn of days, shocks me to the core."
