Course Title: Emergency Paediatric First aid Level 3 Duration: 1 Day

**Broad Aims:** to give the learner the knowledge, skills and confidence to respond effectively, safely and promptly to an emergency situation that may involve babies, toddlers and children within the workplace.

## Overview

This course has been designed and developed for people working with babies, toddlers and children who have a duty to provide emergency first aid cover until professional help arrives.

It has been designed to give the learner the knowledge and practical skills to recognise and treat a number of injuries, conditions and illnesses that are common to babies, toddlers and children from birth to puberty.

The learner will be assessed through ongoing practical observations and a multi choice written exam at the end of the session. Each learner if applicable, will receive an AoFAQ Level 3 certificate in Emergency Paediatric First aid.

**Learning Outcomes:** By the end of the day, learners should be able to:

- Describe the role of the paediatric first aider
- Explain what to do with emergencies
- Demonstrate what to do with an unconscious casualty
- Discuss, practice and perform Cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- Cite the recognition features and treatment of a choking casualty
- Recognise and treat a child in shock
- Discuss and demonstrate the effective treatment of a severe bleed
- Discuss common chronic medical conditions and sudden illness
- Discuss and demonstrate appropriate treatment of bites, stings and minor injuries.
