

Course Title: Health & Safety Level 2

Duration: Full day

Broad Aims: The qualification is aimed at all employees' whether new starters, currently in employment or seeking work.

Overview

The purpose of the qualification is to provide learners with the knowledge to identify workplace hazards and contribute to the positive health and safety culture within the workplace. The qualification contains subjects which are essential in maintaining a safe working environment.

The course is split up into 4 key areas:

1. Roles and Responsibilities
2. Risk Assessment
3. Common workplace hazards
4. Accidents and Incidents in the workplace
