Course Title: Medical Gases/Airway Management Duration: Half day

Broad Aims: To give the learner a better understanding of administrating Medical gas as part of their company requirements.

Overview Reference to QCF

This course is designed to provide learners with an introduction to Medical Gas administration and Airway Management. The course is run over half a day and is made as informative, yet as enjoyable as possible, thus allowing the students to gain confidence in what is possibly a new skill.

Learning Outcomes: By the end of the day, learners will be able to:

- Discuss the reasons for using medical gases
- Cite the legal and ethical requirements of using and storing medical gases at work
- Discuss the roles and responsibilities of the medical gas administrator
- Cite common reasons for the administration of medical gas
- Discuss and practice the use of airway adjuncts and appropriate suctioning devices
- Discuss, demonstrate and practice the safe use of Oxygen and Entonox
- Discuss the contra indication of using medical gases
- Discuss the recording and reporting requirements expected of the user
