Course Title: Paediatric First aid Level 3 Duration: 2 Days

Broad Aims: to give the learner the knowledge, skills and confidence to respond effectively, safely and promptly to an emergency situation that may involve babies, toddlers and children within the workplace.

Overview

This course has been designed and developed for people working with babies, toddlers and children who have a duty to provide first aid cover until professional help arrives.

It has been designed to give the learner the knowledge and practical skills to recognise and treat a number of injuries, conditions and illnesses that are common to babies, toddlers and children from birth to puberty.

The learner will be assessed through ongoing practical observations and a multi choice written exam at the end of the session. Each learner if applicable, will receive an AoFAQ Level 3 certificate in Paediatric First aid.

Learning Outcomes: By the end of the day, learners should be able to:

- Describe the role of the paediatric first aider
- Explain what to do with emergencies
- Demonstrate what to do with an unconscious casualty
- Discuss, practice and perform Cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- Cite the recognition features and treatment of a choking casualty
- Recognise and treat a child in shock
- Demonstrate what to do with bleeding wounds
- Describe common chronic medical conditions and sudden illness
- Discuss the effects of extreme heat and cold
- Demonstrate the appropriate treatment of a suspected fracture and dislocation
- Discuss what to do with head, neck and back injuries
- Describe and discuss conditions affecting the eyes, ears and nose
