


Notes	<p>Communal living excludes living within a household.</p> <p>There are a lot of nil values for communal living; as most people live in households, and by definition people living communally are concentrated.</p> <p>There are, for example, only 125 out of 232,296 Output Areas recorded as having a communal prison population.</p> <p>Communal living is however an important factor. For example, mortality rates for people in a Nursing Care community are very different to those living independently.</p>			
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
