The second tracking report for S4/5/6 is now available to view on Progress. This should give you up to date information about how your young person is progressing with their courses and what their next steps should be to ensure they are successful in their studies. In most cases, the Target Grade and level your young person is working at will not have changed since the first tracking report.

Alongside the target grade, teachers will have indicated the progress your young person is currently making with their learning:

- On Track to Achieve the Target Grade: This indicates that your young person is making good progress towards meeting their set target grade.
- On Track to Pass: This indicates your young person is on course to successfully pass their qualifications or achieve a grade of C or above.
- Off Track (Concern): If your young person is off track, this indicates that they may need to access additional supports or interventions to get back on track.

In addition, you will also see a report on their attitude to learning. This is how well your young person is engaging with their learning. Their attitude towards learning, their level of participation and how well they are contributing to their overall success.

The tracking system also allows teachers to include comments and next steps. These comments will provide you with a deeper understanding of the grades and highlight any necessary support or actions to support continued learning.

Young people in S4 are about to make decisions about the subjects they will take in S5. Please use this tracking report to discuss with them the subjects they should choose to give them the best chance of success next session.
