

Dear Parent/Carer,

As you will be aware following notification from Falkirk Council Children's Services, all schools in Falkirk including Braes High School, will be closed to all pupils on Thursday 24th November. This is due to industrial action by the Educational Institute for Scotland union and the Association of Head teachers and Deputies in Scotland union.

Although the school is closed to pupils, there may be some members of staff who do not participate in the strike action, and will therefore be at work. Those members of staff will provide learning activity to be carried out at home, for pupils who would normally be in their lessons on Thursday. These learning activities will be communicated to pupils via their normal class Teams pages on Thursday. It is understood however that it may not be possible or appropriate for all pupils to carry out these learning activities set by teachers who are at work on Thursday.

Should there be any late change to these arrangements for Thursday, we will of course communicate further.
