Qualification Structure

You will be assigned a personal assessor who will help guide you through the learning criteria for this qualification, delivered as a distance learning qualification. Final assessment is via a multiple-choice exam which is graded as pass/fail.

This qualification is assessed by multiple-choice examination, externally set and marked by Highfield Qualifications. Learners must complete 15 questions within 30 minutes. Successful learners will have to demonstrate knowledge and understanding across the qualification syllabus and achieve a pass mark of 60% (9/15)

Qualification Duration

The total qualification duration for this course is 5 hours. We recommend 4 guided learning hours.

Costs

This course is £90

50% is payable at point of enrolment with the remaining 50% payable upon completion of the qualification.

Who can enrol for this course?

Must be age 16+.

Entry requirements

There are no specific entry requirements however learners should have a minimum of level 1 in literacy and numeracy or equivalent.
