# **Qualification Structure**

This qualification is assessed through an open-response learner workbook:

- This assessment model requires learners to provide short responses to prescribed questions
- The learner will build a portfolio of evidence to support the learning criteria

You will be assigned a personal assessor who will help guide you through the learning criteria for this qualification, delivered as a distance learning qualification.

There are no exams required to achieve the qualification

## **Qualification Duration**

The duration of the qualification depends on whether the learner has had prior learning or prior achievements, as this may reduce the time needed to prepare for the assessment. However, the total time for this qualification is 10 hours. 8 of which, are recommended as guided learning hours.

# Costs

This course is £90

# Who can enrol for this course?

Must be aged 16+.

# **Entry requirements**

It is recommended learners have a level 1 in literacy and numeracy before registering for the qualification.

# Who is this qualification suitable for?

This qualification is designed for

- Adult care worker
- Healthcare assistant/support worker
- Teachers
- Anyone working with Children and Young People across a variety of settings

The objective of this qualification is to support a role in the workplace. Learners may be working, or wishing to work, with children and young people. This includes those in voluntary or unpaid roles. The qualification covers how to safeguard and protect children, young people and practitioners in the workplace as well as how to respond to evidence or concerns that a child or young person has been abused.

Children are those aged below 16 and young people are those aged between 16 and 18. Working Together to Safeguard Children 2015, Keeping Children Safe in Education (KCSIE) and the Children Act 2004, place duties on a range of organisations to ensure they have regard to the need to safeguard and promote the welfare of children. This includes the need for appropriate safeguarding training, as employers are responsible for ensuring staff are competent to carry out their responsibilities towards the safeguarding of children and young people.

This qualification can be used to support the training of employees.
