## Qualification Structure

The objective of this qualification is to support a role in the workplace. You will be assigned a personal assessor who will help guide you through the learning criteria for this qualification, delivered as a distance learning qualification. Final assessment is via a multiple-choice exam which is graded as pass/fail.

This qualification is assessed by a 25-question multiple-choice test.  
Successful learners must achieve a minimum pass mark of 17 correct answers (68%).

## Qualification Duration

The total qualification duration for this course is 7 hours and we recommend 7 guided learning hours.

## Costs

This course is £70  
50% is payable at point of enrolment with the remaining 50% payable upon completion of the qualification.
