all looked amazing and enjoyed a variety of Pirate themed activities.























WHAT'S HAPPENING THIS MONTH IN THE


Parents can be involved in the topic by sharing bedtime stories about fish, singing the topic songs at home and talking about what we find in the sea during bath-time.


