children have settled in so well.







Please can we ask you ensure your child brings spare clothes to nursery each day. Millwood House does not keep a supply of spare clothes. Please ensure you label all your child's belongings to avoid disappointment if they are returned to the wrong owner.

Please be reminded that our sessions finish at 1pm and 6pm.

Millwood House follows strict ratios, and the late collection of children at 1pm has an impact on staff being able to adhere to these ratios as well as being able to have a well-deserved lunch break.

Likewise, late collection after 6pm requires 2 members of staff to wait with the child until they are collected. This has an impact on staff transport, as well as depriving them of precious time with their own families after working a very long day.
