WEEK 5

STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

NB - These instructions use **UK** crochet terms throughout - **US** terms are given in brackets below where applicable

ch - chain

dc - double crochet (US single crochet)

rep - repeat

rnd(s) - round(s)

rs - right side

sp - space

ss - slip stitch

st(s) - stitch(es)

tr - treble (US double crochet)

ws - wrong side

yoh - yarn over hook

TIPS & TECHNIQUES NOTES

The border is worked in joined rnds with the rs of the blanket facing until the 7th rnd when you turn and work in the opposite direction on the ws of the blanket.

You should work 138 sts across the top and bottom of your blanket.

When working along the sides of your blanket your own tension will determine the number of sts. Start with 1 dc into the end of each dc row and 2 dc into the ends of tr rows (including Criss Cross, Puff-Stitch and V-Stitch rows). If your work is pulling you will need to add extra sts, if it starts to become wavy work less sts. Adjusting your st count in this way will help you achieve a beautiful border.

WEEK 5 CAL PATTERN BLANKET BORDER

1st Rnd. (rs of blanket) Yarn F, Double Crochet Stitch: Using Yarn F, 1 ch, (1 dc, 2 ch, 1 dc) into 1st st (to make 1st corner), 1 dc into each st to last st, (1 dc, 2 ch, 1 dc) all into last st (to make 2nd corner), work dc evenly down side edge, (1 dc, 2 ch, 1 dc) all into lower edge of 1st foundation ch (to make 3rd corner), 1 dc into each foundation ch to last ch, (1 dc, 2 ch, 1 dc) all into last ch (to make 4th corner), work dc evenly up side edge, ss into 1st dc to close rnd.

2nd Rnd. 1 ch, 1 dc into 1st dc, (1 dc, 2 ch, 1 dc) into corner 2 ch sp, * 1 dc into each dc to next corner 2 ch sp,

THIS WEEK'S STITCH HOW TO'S

DOUBLE CROCHET STITCH

Insert hook into indicated st, yoh, draw yarn through st (2 loops on hook), yoh and draw yarn through 2 loops on hook.

NEW THIS WEEK - BORDER V STITCH

(1 tr, 1 ch, 1 tr) into same st

(1 dc, 2 ch, 1 dc) into corner 2 ch sp, * rep from * to * twice more, 1 dc into each dc to end, ss into 1st dc.

Fasten off.

3rd Rnd. Yarn A, Border V Stitch:

Attach Yarn A into any corner 2 ch sp, 3 ch (3 ch counts as 1st tr here and in following rnds), 1 tr into same 2 ch sp, 2 ch, 2 tr into same 2 ch sp, miss next 2 sts, * (1 tr, 1 ch, 1 tr) into next st, miss next 2 sts, * rep from * to * to next corner 2 ch sp, (2 tr, 2 ch, 2 tr) into 2 ch sp, miss next 2 sts, rep from * to * to next corner 2 ch sp, (2 tr, 2 ch, 2 tr) into 2 ch sp, rep from * to * to end, ss into top of 3 ch. Fasten off.

(You may only have to skip 1 st or 0 sts when you reach the corners as this is dependent on the number of sts you have worked along the edges of your border on your 1st rnd. This will not affect the overall look of your blanket).

4th Rnd. Yarn C: Attach Yarn C into any corner 2 ch sp, 3 ch, 1 tr into same 2 ch sp, 2 ch, 2 tr into same 2 ch sp, * 2 tr into sp between next 2 tr, (1 tr, 1 ch, 1 tr) into 1 ch sp of each border V-st to next corner 2 tr, 2 tr into sp between next 2 tr, (2 tr, 2 ch, 2 tr) into 2 ch sp, * rep from * to * twice more, 2 tr into sp between next 2 tr, (1 tr, 1 ch, 1 tr) into 1 ch sp of each border V-st to last corner 2 tr, 2 tr into sp between last 2 tr, ss into top of 3 ch. Fasten off.

5th Rnd. Yarn A: Attach Yarn A into any corner 2 ch sp, 3 ch, 1 tr into same 2 ch sp, 2 ch, 2 tr into same 2 ch sp, * (2 tr into sp between next 2 tr) twice, (1 tr, 1 ch, 1 tr) into 1 ch sp of each border V-st to last 4 tr before next corner 2 ch sp, (2 tr into sp between next 2 tr) twice, (2 tr, 2 ch, 2 tr) into 2 ch sp, * rep from * to * twice more, (2 tr into sp between next 2 tr) twice, (1 tr, 1 ch, 1 tr) into 1 ch sp of each border

NEW THIS WEEK - PICOT STITCH

1 dc into next st, 3 ch, ss into top of dc on which 3 ch stands

V-st to last 4 tr, (2 tr into sp between next 2 tr) twice, ss into top of 3 ch. Fasten off.

6th Rnd. Yarn B, Double Crochet

Stitch: Attach Yarn B into any corner 2 ch sp, 1 ch (1 ch does not count as a st), 1 dc into 2 ch sp, 2 ch, 1 dc into same 2 ch sp, * 1 dc into each tr and 1 ch sp to next corner 2 ch sp, (1 dc, 2 ch, 1 dc) into corner 2 ch sp, * rep from * to * twice more, 1 dc into each tr and 1 ch sp to end, ss into 1st dc, turn.

7th Rnd. Picot Stitch: Working on ws, * 1 dc into each of 1st 7 dc, picot-st into next dc, rep from * to end, working 3 dc into each corner 2 ch sp. (You may have to alter the number of dc before the last picot-st in the rnd as this is dependent on the number of sts you have worked along the sides of your border on the first rnd. This will not affect the overall look of your blanket).

Fasten off and weave in ends.



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
