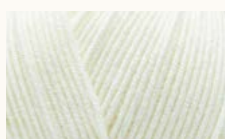

WINTER BERRIES COWL

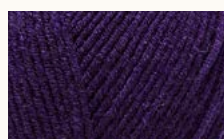


We hope you've enjoyed crocheting along with Sharna as much as we have. To use up any leftover yarn from your blanket, Sharna has created this matching cowl.

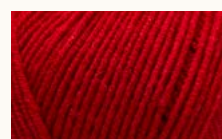
Using the same stitches as your Winter Berries blanket, follow the pattern to make a simple rectangle, then sew the two short edges together to complete your cowl.



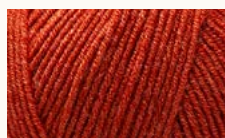

SIZE & TENSION

Circumference 66 cm, (26")
(approximately)



Depth 22 cm, (8 $\frac{3}{4}$ ")
(approximately)

The measurement given for the circumference of this cowl is based on a tension of 16 stitches to 10cm, (4").



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STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

NB - These instructions use **UK** crochet terms throughout - **US** terms are given in brackets below where applicable

ch - chain

cm - centimetres

DK - double knitting

dc - double crochet (US single crochet)

g - grammes

rep - repeat

rs - right side

st(s) - stitch(es)

tr - treble (US double crochet)

yoh - yarn over hook

TIPS & TECHNIQUES NOTES

The foundation chains can be worked on a 4.00 hook taking care not to work the chains too tightly or if you prefer you can use a 5.00 hook to make the foundation chains then change to your 4.00 hook before starting the 1st row.

All odd numbered rows are worked on the right side of the cowl and all even numbered rows are worked on the wrong side of the cowl.

1ch at the beginning of each dc, bobble-st and lemon peel-st row is a turning chain and not counted as a stitch.

2ch at the beginning of each tr and criss cross-st row is a turning chain and not counted as a stitch.

WEEK 6 CAL PATTERN (Cowl)

Foundation Chain. Using **Yarn A** and 4.00 hook make 107ch, taking care not to work the chains too tightly. If you prefer you can use a 5.00 hook to make the chains and change to a 4.00 hook before starting the 1st row.

1st Row. (rs of cowl) Yarn A, Double Crochet Stitch: 1dc in 2nd ch from hook, * 1dc in next ch, rep from * to end, changing to Yarn D on last yoh of last dc, turn. 106dc.

2nd Row. Yarn D, Treble Crochet Stitch: 2ch, 1tr into 1st st, * 1tr into next st, rep from * to end, turn.

3rd Row. As 2nd row, changing to Yarn E on last yoh of last tr.

4th Row. Yarn E, Criss Cross Stitch: 2ch, 1tr into 1st st, * miss next st, 1tr into next st then working in front of

THIS WEEK'S STITCH HOW TO'S

DOUBLE CROCHET STITCH

Insert hook into indicated st, yoh, draw yarn through st (2 loops on hook), yoh and draw yarn through 2 loops on hook.

TREBLE CROCHET STITCH

Yoh, insert hook into indicated st, yoh, draw yarn through st (3 loops on hook), yoh and draw yarn through 1st 2 loops on hook (2 loops left on hook), yoh and draw yarn through last 2 loops on hook.

CRISS CROSS STITCH

Miss next st, 1tr into next st then working in front of the tr just made, 1tr into the missed st.

BOBBLE STITCH

* Yoh, insert hook into indicated st, yoh and draw a loop through, yoh and draw through 1st 2 loops on hook, * working into same st rep from * to * 3 times more, yoh and draw through all 5 loops on hook.

LEMON PEEL STITCH

Alternate tr and dc sts worked across row, on following rows work 1dc into each tr and 1tr into each dc.

the tr just made, 1tr into the missed st, rep from * to last st, 1tr into last st, changing to Yarn B on the last yoh of last tr, turn.

5th Row. Yarn B, Double Crochet Stitch: 1ch, 1dc into 1st st, * 1dc into next st, rep from * to end, turn.

6th Row. Bobble Stitch: 1ch, 1dc into each of 1st 7 sts, bobble-st into next st, * 1dc into each of next 7 sts, bobble-st into next st, rep from * to last 2 sts, 1dc into each of last 2 sts, turn.

7th Row. Treble Crochet Stitch: 2ch, 1tr into 1st st, * 1tr into next st, rep from * to end, turn.

8th Row. Bobble Stitch: 1ch, 1dc into each of 1st 3 sts, bobble-st into next st, * 1dc into each of next 7 sts, bobble-st into next st, rep from * to last 6 sts, 1dc into each of last 6 sts, changing to Yarn G on last yoh of last dc, turn.

9th Row. Yarn G, Lemon Peel Stitch: 1ch, 1dc into 1st st, * 1tr into next st, 1dc into next st, rep from * to last st, 1tr into last st, turn.

10th Row. 1ch, 1dc into 1st tr, * 1tr into next dc, 1dc into next tr, rep from * to last dc, 1tr into last dc, changing to Yarn A on last yoh of last tr, turn.

11th Row. Yarn A, Treble Crochet Stitch: As 2nd row, changing to Yarn C on last yoh of last tr.

12th Row. Yarn C, Bobble Stitch: As 6th row.

13th Row. Treble Crochet Stitch: As 2nd row.

14th Row. Bobble Stitch: As 8th row.

15th Row. Treble Crochet Stitch: As 2nd row.

16th Row. Bobble Stitch: As 6th row, changing to Yarn F on last yoh of last dc.

17th Row. Yarn F, Treble Crochet Stitch: As 2nd row.

18th Row. Treble Crochet Stitch: As 2nd row, changing to Yarn B on last yoh of last tr.

19th Row. Yarn B, Double Crochet Stitch: As 5th row.

20th Row. Bobble Stitch: As 6th row, changing to Yarn A on last yoh of last dc.

21st Row. Yarn A, Treble Crochet Stitch: As 2nd row, changing to Yarn E on last yoh of last tr.

22nd Row. Yarn E, Criss Cross Stitch: As 4th row, changing to Yarn D on last yoh of last tr.

23rd and 24th Rows. Yarn D, Treble Crochet Stitch: As 2nd row, changing to Yarn G on last yoh of last tr of 24th row.

25th Row. Yarn G, Double Crochet Stitch: 1ch, 1dc into 1st st, * 1dc into next st, rep from * to end, do not turn, fasten off Yarn G.

26th Row. Yarn A, Double Crochet Stitch: With rs facing, join A into 1st st of 25th row, 1ch, 1dc into 1st st, * 1dc into next st, rep from * to end. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing. Weave in loose ends then using the tail from end of 26th row, sew the 2 short sides of the cowl together to form a loop.
