
HOW TO BASIC STITCHES MAGIC RING




Make a loop with the yarn

Insert the crochet hook from the outside to the inside

Take the yarn with the crochet hook and pass it through the loop




Repeat until you have the number if stitches needed



CHAIN STITCH

With the sliding knot on your crochet hook, cast on the yarn by passing it through the loop.



SLIP STITCH


Insert the crochet hook into the stitch, hook the yarn and take it through the two loops.





DOUBLE CROCHET

Insert the crochet hook through the stitch, hook the yarn and pull it through the loop; there will be 2 loops on the hook. Hook the yarn again and take it through both loops.



TREBLE CROCHET

Hook the yarn before inserting the crochet hook into the stitch and take it through the loop. Hook the yarn again and take it through the first two loops. Hook the yarn once more and pull it through the two remaining loops.



HALF TREBLE CROCHET

Hook the yarn before inserting the hook from front to back in the centre of the third chain. Hook the yarn and draw through 3 loops on hook. To repeat hook the yarn, insert hook in the centre of next chain, hook the yarn, draw yarn through stitch, hook the yarn draw yarn through 3 loops on hook.



TO INCREASE

Increasing is achieved by working two or more stitches in the pattern where there would normally be one stitch worked.





TO DECREASE

Insert the hook into thee next stitch, wind the yarn round the hook and draw a loop through. Repeat this action into the following stitch (three loops now on the hook). Wind the yarn round the hook and draw it through all three loops.





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MATERIALS

F234 Happy Cotton

 Colour A - 761
 I ball

 Colour B - 760
 I ball

 Colour C - 764
 I ball

 Colour D - 795
 I ball

/ 3.00 Hook

Toy stuffing

8mm Safety eyesTapestry needle

TENSION

Exact tension not essential, keep stitches close together amigurumi style so no stuffing shows through gaps.

ABBREVIATIONS

NB These instructions use UK crochet terms throughout – US terms are given in brackets below where applicable

ch - chain

cm - centimetres

dc - double crochet (US single crochet)

dc2tog - (insert hook into next stitch, yoh and draw through) twice, yoh and draw through 3 loops.

in - inch(es)

mm - millimetres

rnd(s) - round(s)

st - stitch

tog - together

yoh - yarn over hook

EYE PATCHES (Make 2)

Using A make a magic ring.

1st Rnd. 6dc into magic ring. **2nd Rnd.** 2dc in each dc. 12dc.

3rd Rnd. (Idc, 2dc in next dc) 6 times. 18dc.

Change to D, leaving a tail in A for sewing.

4th Rnd. 18dc.

Fasten off.

HEAD AND BODY

Using B make a magic ring.

Ist Rnd. 7dc into magic ring.

2nd Rnd. 2dc in each dc. 14dc.

3rd Rnd. (1dc, 2dc in next dc) 7 times. 21dc.

4th Rnd. (2dc, 2dc in next dc) 7 times. 28dc.

5th Rnd. (3dc, 2dc in next dc) 7 times. 35dc.

6th Rnd. (4dc, 2dc in next dc) 7 times. 42dc.

7th to 11th Rnd. 42dc

13th Rnd. (Dc2tog, 3dc) 7 times. 28dc. 14th Rnd. (3dc, 2dc in next dc) 7 times. 35dc. 15th Rnd. (4dc, 2dc in next dc) 7 times. 42dc. Insert a safety eye into the centre of each eye patch then insert between 8th and 9th rnds of head

12th Rnd. (Dc2tog, 4dc) 7 times. 35dc.

16th to 20th Rnd. 42dc.
21st Rnd. (Dc2tog, 4dc) 7 times. 35dc.
22nd Rnd. (Dc2tog, 3dc) 7 times. 28dc.
23rd Rnd. (Dc2tog, 2dc) 7 times. 21dc.
Add plenty of stuffing.
24th Rnd. (Dc2tog, 1dc) 7 times. 14dc.
25th Rnd. (Dc2tog) 7 times. 7dc.
Fasten off, pick up all the front loops with a needle and pull tight to close.

EARS (Make 2)

Using B make a magic ring.

Ist Row. 4dc into magic ring, turn.

2nd Row. Ich (Ich does not count as a st),

2dc in each dc. 8dc.

3rd Row. Ich, 2dc in each dc, turn. I6dc.

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

FRONT DETAIL PIECES (Make 2 in C and 2 in D)

Make a magic loop.

Ist Row. 4dc into magic ring, turn.
2nd Row. Ich (Ich does not count as a st),
2dc in each dc. 8dc.

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

TO COMPLETE

Secure the eye patches with the yarn tails, leaving last rnd sticking out.

Folding the base of the ears slightly, sew the ears on either side of the head.

Sew the top straight edges of the front detail pieces to the body in rows, refer to photograph for positioning.

Using D embroider a V shaped beak between the eyes.
