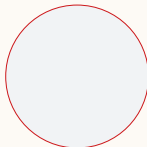

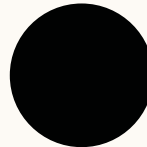

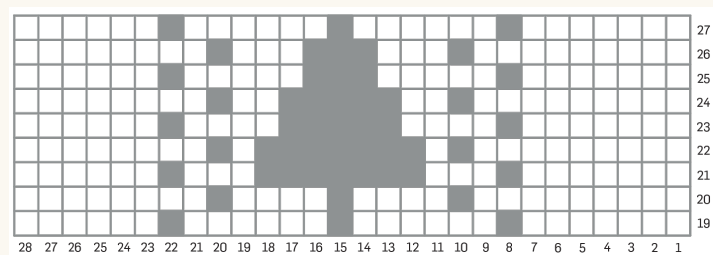

TENSION

Each stocking measures approx 14cm x 7cm. Tension is not critical. A slight difference in the size of each stocking will add to the handmade charm of your Advent Calendar.

Rounds 6-8 dc in each st, [28 sts]

Change to colour A for the body of the sock.

Rounds 9-16 dc in each st, [28 sts]

Round 17 ch14 (make them quite loose), skip 14 sts from the previous round, 14 dc, [14dc+14ch]

Round 18 14dc (work into ch), 14dc, [28 sts]

Rounds 19-27 Follow the chart below from rounds 19 to 27 working in tapestry crochet. It may help to use a stitch marker in the last stitch of each round, moving it up as you work.

RIBBING

Round 28 dc in each st, [28 sts]

Change to colour B.

Round 29 (1dc, 1tr) 14 times, [28 sts]

Rounds 30 - 31 (1dc, 1fp) 14 times, [28 sts]
Ss into the next st. Fasten off and weave in ends.

HEEL

Join colour B to the first skipped stitch of round 17.

Round 1 14dc into the skipped sts of round 17, 14dc under the foundation ch of the leg, [28 sts]

Round 2 (dc2tog, 10dc, dc2tog) 2 times, [24 sts]

Round 3 (dc2tog, 8dc, dc2tog) 2 times, [20 sts]

Round 4 (dc2tog, 6dc, dc2tog) 2 times, [16 sts]

Round 5 dc2tog 8 times, [8 sts]

TO COMPLETE

With a tapestry needle, insert the needle into each front loop of the last round, pull to close the hole and weave in the ends.

Make a Hanging Loop

Join the yarn at the base of one st of round 29, ch25, ss into the first ch to close the loop. Fasten off and weave in ends.

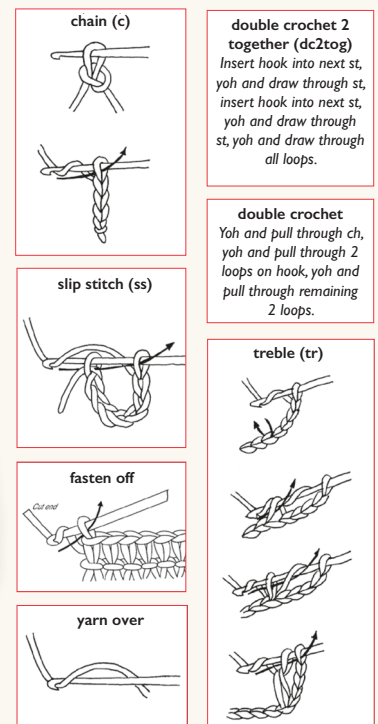

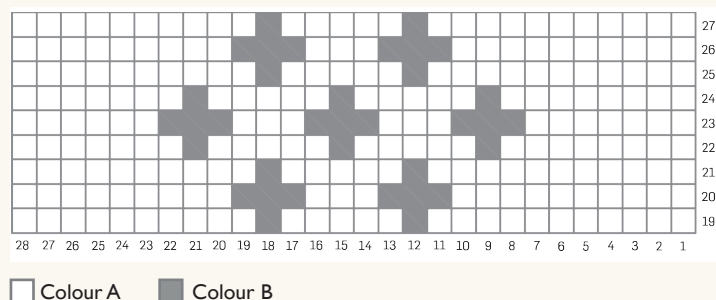

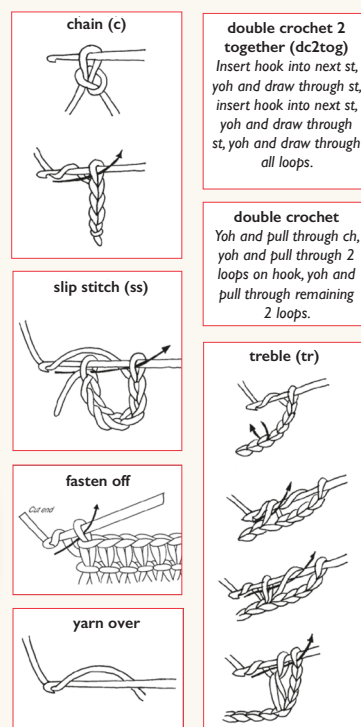

Round 1 14dc into the skipped sts of round 17, 14dc under the foundation ch of the leg, [28 sts]

Round 2 (dc2tog, 10dc, dc2tog) 2 times, [24 sts]

Round 3 (dc2tog, 8dc, dc2tog) 2 times, [20 sts]

Round 4 (dc2tog, 6dc, dc2tog) 2 times, [16 sts]

Round 5 dc2tog 8 times, [8 sts]

Join the yarn at the base of one st of round 29, ch25, ss into the first ch to close the loop. Fasten off and weave in ends.

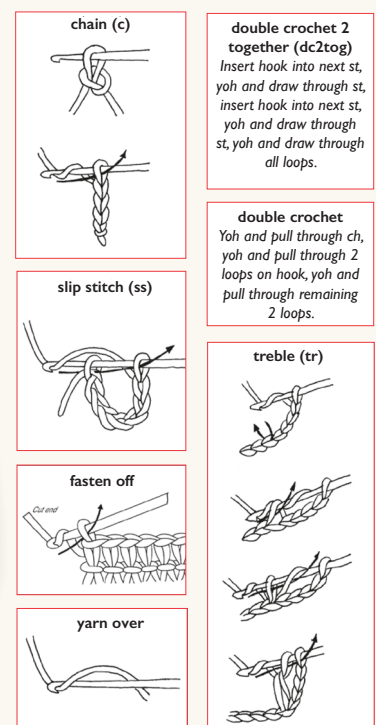
Embroider Advent Numbers
