## Course overview:

The purpose of this session is to provide learners with the basic knowledge to identify workplace hazards and contribute to the positive health and safety culture within the workplace

- · State how a risk assessment can be used to reduce accidents and ill health at work
- · State the common hazards found in the workplace
- Describe how common workplace hazards can cause harm or damage to people, organisations and property
- · Describe the principles of risk control
- · List examples of risk control for common workplace hazards
- · Identify the categories of common workplace signage
- · List the common causes of workplace accidents
- · State the requirements for reporting workplace accidents
- · List the factors which can contribute to causing accidents in the workplace

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
