Exhibtd Application Guidance

Exhibtd is an online art marketplace where artists can sell directly to buyers with 0% commission and no listing fees. This guide takes you through the practical steps to check your eligibility, prepare your application and help you to write a successful application.

Check Your Eligibility

- You live in Great Britain, Jersey, Guernsey or the Isle of Man
- You have an active <u>Artist or Artist Plus subscription</u> on CuratorSpace. A working <u>CuratorSpace profile link</u> is the simplest way to confirm this
- You create contemporary art or craft which is available to purchase (eg. painting, drawing, sculpture, photography, digital art, ceramics, textiles, jewellery, limited edition prints)

Select representative artworks

- Choose up to 5 works that clearly represent your style and practice
- Each image should be sharp, well-lit, and taken against a white or neutral background or cropped-close
- Accompany each image with a short description that includes how it was made and the idea behind it

Write your artist bio (Max 150 words)

- Your artist bio is where you can highlight your experience and credibility
- Provide a brief paragraph about yourself that highlights relevant qualifications eg. education, residencies, awards, exhibitions, any professional affiliations, etc
- You do not need to have professional qualifications to be eligible
- Keep the tone concise and relevant to your artistic experience

Write your artist statement (Max 300 words)

- Your artist statement should explain the materials, techniques and concepts behind your work
- Provide 1-2 paragraphs about your process, including any themes or inspiration

Provide your website or social media links (optional)

- If you have a website, a social media profile or online shop, include the links here
- This provides extra proof of audience engagement and allows us to explore a broader view of your portfolio, including any experience you have of selling online
