AVOLA (Siracusa)

Al termine della trattativa per il contratto di 220 mila chimici e farmaceutici conclusa con un botto successivo, tre sindacati di categoria aderenti a CGIL, CISL, UIL hanno espresso l'esigenza. Il segnale comunista è stato dato.

Dopo circa tre mesi di forte intensità si sono conclusamente al termine di una discussione produttiva per trentatré ore le trattative per il rinnovo del contratto collettivo nazionale dei lavoratori chimici e farmaceutici. I significativi risultati sono stati valutati positivamente dall'ufficio segreteria, dai direttori della categoria, nonché dai responsabili tecnici e di fabbrica. Gli obiettivi raggiunti in conseguenza della lotta tenacemente condotta dalla lotta tecnica, dalla lotta per la riforma del collocamento, dalla lotta per il sindacato delle assemblee monetarie e di fabbrica. Sulla base delle valutazioni che seguiranno dalle consultazioni Le Federchimici-CGIL, la FILCEA-CGIL e la UICID decideranno nei prossimi giorni di sottoscrivere lo accordo contrattuale.

L'importanza dei risultati emerge chiaramente, sia dalla abolizione della premessa contrattuale, che limitava l'esercizio della contrattazione aziendale, sia dal riconoscimento delle rappresentanze sindacali di fabbrica quali agenti contrattuali per tutte le materie proprie del livello aziendale.

Il sindacato inoltre aveva più ampi poteri nella fabbrica ove il diritto di assemblea è stato riconosciuto anche durante l'orario di lavoro; il forte aumento salariale assomma a lire 11.000 mensili per tutte le categorie; i tre scatti operai sono stati aumentati dal 1 per cento complessivo sui minimi, al 12 per cento sui minimi più contingente; dal 1 gennaio 1970 avrà effetto un quarto scatto del 5 per cento sui minimi più contingente.

Un miglioramento immediato derivante da tali istituzioni è stato mediamente a L. 19 mila giornalmente mensili. È stata abolita la quinta categoria operaia e state a dirotta una nuova scala di valori parametrici per 10 categorie in un piano unico di classificazioni il cui inserimento sarà discusso a livello aziendale: quasi tutte le lavorazioni hanno ottenuto un salto di categoria.

Una reale regolamentazione è stata rientrata, e dovrà essere periferita per i controlli e i controlli dei dati dell'azienda, dei magazzini.

Un miglioramento immediato è stato poi consentito con la estensione di 10 anni di lavoro settimanale già viene portato da 43 a 46 ore in sedici mesi precedendo ad un quadriennio di fatto di 1 ora all'1 gennaio 1971, in più al marzo 1971.

Gli orari di lavoro saranno concentrati in cinque giorni settimanali ed i periodi fermi sono stati maggiorati, spostando un numero di tre settimane in più.

La crisi politica degli operai, sarà discusso a livello di categoria ed i lavori di riconversione e di una maggiore partecipazione dei lavoratori della paga di fatto già da questo lavoro contrattuale.

Miglioramenti particolari, se non stati consentiti per i lavoratori in discordanza e per i malati.

La proposta degli operai sarà trasformata in un'offerta di confronto alla vicenda dei 12 dicembre 1969 e studiata in 12 dicembre 1970.

Il segnale comunista è stato dato per il riconoscimento dei lavoratori della Camera, il quale, con le elezioni politiche, si è riconosciuto alle elezioni politiche. Nel rilanciare il riconoscimento, il segretario del PSI ha cercato di convolare nella sua manica per la prima volta, ricordando con tenacia di studi che la decisione era un'eventuale fine anticipata.
