


# Witchy Star Catching.




Using the <u>Stars</u> activity from Sensory Space, create a magical star hunt full of sparkle and surprise!

- Print and decorate our star shapes using fun textures like sandpaper, felt, or glitter.
- To make the 'sky,' use uncooked rice or pasta. Add a few drops of black food colouring or simply mix in black poster paint / watered-down acrylic paint for a budget-friendly option. Leave to dry overnight.
- Hide the stars in the rice or pasta, then invite learners to search for them.
- They can scoop up stars using a spoon, jug, or net.
- Add glow lights or sprinkle glitter into the tray for a dazzling Halloween effect.
- **Optional:** Attach stars to a sound button (e.g. a talking tile) with spooky sounds to make the hunt even more engaging.







# **Slithery Snake Potion.**



Get ready for some slimy, spooky fun with our <u>Snakes</u> activity from Sensory Space! Learners can whip up their very own Halloween potion with a green, gooey slime packed with hidden creepy-crawlies. It's messy play at its best, perfect for sensory exploration, cause and effect learning, and plenty of giggles.


#### **Materials:**

- 1 cup cornflour (cornstarch).
- 1 cup water.
- A few drops of green food colouring (or poster paint mixed with water as a cheaper option).
- Optional: glitter or Halloween confetti.
- **Small toys:** plastic spiders, frogs, or cooked pasta "snakes".

#### How to make:

- **Mix the Colour** Add water to a bowl and stir in the colouring. Learners can get involved too if they're able.
- **Sprinkle the Cornflour** Slowly add the cornflour, stirring to watch the texture change from liquid to slimy.
- **Get Messy!** Squish, stir, and dig around to find the hidden creepy-crawlies.
- Make it Magical Add glitter, confetti, or even tip the slime into a "cauldron" or tray for extra spooky effect.

# **Bubbling Potion Jars.**



Use our <u>Bubbles</u> activity from Sensory Space. Make your own bubbling potion bottles that shimmer and swirl with every shake! Learners can choose colours, glitter, and even spooky toys to hide inside. Just like in Sensory Space Bubbles, every shake brings the potion to life with sparkles and floating blobs.

#### **Materials:**

- Clear plastic jar or bottle with a secure lid.
- Water (fill about ¾ full).
- Food colouring (let learners choose).
- Glitter, sequins, or confetti.
- 1–2 tablespoons of baby oil (vegetable oil also works).
- **Optional:** small plastic spiders, stars, or frogs.


#### How to make:

- Fill the bottle with water and colouring.
- Add glitter, confetti, or sequins for sparkle.
- Pour in a spoonful of oil and watch as blobs form and float!
- Drop in a spooky toy for surprise fun.
- Seal the lid with strong tape or glue to avoid spills.

#### Tip:

• Pair this activity with our **communication board** (symbols for shake, stop, look, more, finished) to support choice-making and participation.



# Magical Halloween Growing Patterns.



Turn simple ingredients into spooky science art! This activity is great for using alongside our **Growing Patterns** activity from Games & Activities. Learners can drip colours onto icing and watch as magical patterns spread and grow, just like potions bubbling to life. It's a hands-on way to explore colour mixing, sequencing, and sensory play with a Halloween sparkle.

#### **Materials:**

- Glossy paper or laminated paper (any smooth surface works).
- Runny icing (royal icing thinned with a little water).
- Liquid food colouring.
- Pipettes or droppers.
- Optional: glitter or edible sparkles.


#### How to make:

- Spread a thin layer of runny icing over the paper or tray.
- Use pipettes to drop food colouring onto the icing.
- Watch as the colours spread, mix, and create swirling, marbled "growing" patterns.

#### Tips:

- Keep the icing layer thin so colours spread easily.
- Work on a tray to catch drips and keep things tidy.
- Laminated or glossy paper gives the most dramatic effects.
- Add glitter or edible sparkles for extra Halloween magic.

#### **Five Wicked Witches.**



Bring this spooky counting song to life on and off screen! Learners can enjoy the interactive version of in Games & Activities, or join in with a hands-on activity that supports counting down, sequencing, and participation.

#### How to play:

- Print and cut out the five witches and the spoon and laminate.
- Print out the cauldron and laminate.
- Add Velcro dots to the back of each witch and place them around the cauldron.
- Start the <u>Five Wicked Witches</u> song in Games & Activities.
- As you sing, learners can remove a witch that matches the colour band on her hat.
- Stir the potion with the laminated spoon (or even a real wooden spoon!) to bring the magic to life.












# Five Speckled Frogs Halloween Fun.





Learners wait for the lights to come on in the haunted house and then make a selection to watch the guests animate. To make this even more interactive, we've created a Haunted House Choice Board.


#### How to play:


- Open the <u>Haunted House</u> activity in Games & Activities.

- When the lights switch on, see if their guess was correct as the spooky guest comes to life!





# Splat Ghosts (Ghost Hunt).







#### How to play:


- Print and cut out the ghost images.

Every monster needs a makeover! With this activity, learners can design their very own spooky character.


Linking to our HelpKidzLearn <u>Make a Monster</u> activity, we've created a fun paper-based version for learners to design their very own spooky character.

- Once finished, invite learners to give their monster a name and introduce it to the group.










## **Monster Trapdoor.**




Bring the monster fun off screen with this exciting memory and matching game! Great for using alongside the **Monster Trapdoor**. Learners can pair up spooky characters, drop them through a homemade trapdoor or box, and add sound effects for extra Halloween magic.


Place a sound button nearby with a spooky effect (monster laugh, boo, or magic chime) to add extra excitement.

#### How to play:

- Print the monster character cards and cut out.
- Lay the cards face down and take turns turning them over to find a match.
- When learners find a pair, they can drop the monsters through a decorated trapdoor or into a cardboard box.
- Add sound buttons nearby (e.g. monster laughs, spooky "boo!" or magic chimes). Learners press them each time they make a match for extra fun.
- Decorate the trapdoor box with Halloween characters to make it even more engaging.

## Aunty Maggie's Magical Recipe.



It's time to mix up some spooky potions! In this activity, learners become potion-makers, combining characters, jars, and monster transformations to create their own magical stories. It's a brilliant way to practise sequencing, choice-making, and imaginative play. Use alongside **Aunty Maggie's Recipe**.

#### How to play:

- Choose a character Print and cut out the characters provided (e.g. Max the Magician, Leo the Wizard, Luna the Witch, Zara the Spell Maker). Learners pick who will make the potion.
- Add potion jars Lay out the potion jars and encourage learners to choose as many as they like to build their recipe. Each jar represents a different magical ingredient (e.g. bat wings, frog legs, bubbles).
- Mix it up Use a cup, bowl, or cauldron to act out mixing the potions together. Encourage learners to join in with sound effects like "flap flap" for bat wings or "fizz fizz" for bubbles.
- Monster transformation Finally, learners choose a monster card. Act
  out the transformation together, with fun actions like stomping, twirling, or
  roaring.



"Norbert has a cold, which means his bogies are extra chilly! This easy recipe gives you around 20 dollops of glorious green gunge! Lovely!"


#### **Ingredients:**


- 250g icing sugar.
- 1 egg white (you can use egg white powder if you wish.)
- A few drops of peppermint essence.
- Dark chocolate.



#### **Method:**

- 1) Weigh out 250g icing sugar
- 2) Sieve the sugar into a large bowl.
- 3) Add half of the egg white.
- 4) Add a few drops of the peppermint essence and mix really well.
- 5) Slowly keep adding a little egg white at a time until it turns into a dough.
- 6) Divide the mixture into about 20 balls.
- 7) Gently flatten them into discs.
- 8) Put the discs on some baking parchment.
- 9) Break some plain chocolate into a microwavable bowl.
- 10) Use a switch to melt the chocolate in 30 second intervals.
- 11) Dip the peppermint creams in the melted chocolate until they are half coated.
- 12) Lay them back on the baking parchment to set for 3-4 hours or overnight.
