Interns become part of the wider Exodus Community.

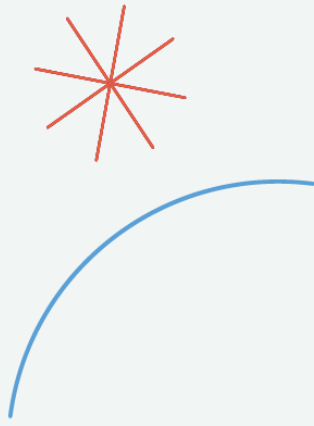
Expectations include:

- This position can be based in either Belfast or Lisburn.

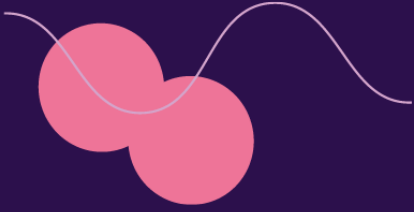
