### INTRODUCTION

The brochure **Flanders in Figures** gives a concise picture of Flanders based on a limited set of Flemish public statistics. The statistics cover a wide range of themes and are grouped into four main sections: population and society, economy and enterprises, spatial and living environment, and government and governance. At the end, a short comparison is made between the data for Flanders and the situation in Belgium and the rest of the European Union.

On this website, the statistics included in this brochure can be viewed in more detail, as well as the corresponding data sets and information about the sources and definitions used.

The statistics in this brochure always refer to the **Flemish Region**, except where it is indicated that they concern the **Flemish Community**. The Flemish Region is authorised for matters relating to the territory, the so-called 'place-specific' matters (e.g. economy). Matters relating directly to the inhabitants, the so-called 'person-related' matters (e.g. culture), fall under the authority of the Flemish Community.

In this way, citizens, organisations and companies are provided with fast, reliable, correct and independent information about Flanders.

We develop, produce and publish all official statistics about Flanders in accordance with the legal provisions and international principles of quality, relevance and professional independence. These principles are also reflected in the four strategic objectives that guide the work of Statistics Flanders:

- We work innovatively and focus on the future.

The Flanders Statistics Authority (VSA), headed by the chief statistician of the Flemish government, coordinates and supports the Statistics Flanders network so that the development, production and dissemination of official statistics by the network is done in a qualitative and systematic way.






Births — Deaths




# Life expectancy at birth

(expected years of life)






### Deaths per month\* (number)






### People on temporary unemployment benefit per month




### Personal income per month of the population (aged 18 and over)




### Breakdown of population by net equivalent household income



### Population below the poverty threshold (%)




### Population living in households making ends meet with difficulty (%)


Share of 25-34 year olds with a higher education diploma (%)








### Participation rate in education and training (aged 25-64) over past 4 weeks (%)





### **Cultural participation (aged** 18 and over) in 2021 (% at least once a year)





Overall life satisfaction of population (aged 18 and over) in 2021 (score out of 10)








### Leading causes of death in 2019












# Formal childcare places for babies and toddlers<sup>®</sup> (number)


# Population in residential care centres in 2020 (%)



# Population (aged 18 and over) practising sports at least annually in 2021 (%)













### Paralympic top sports




### Real economic growth (%)









### **Labour productivity**\* (euro PPS)




### **Goods exports**

(billion euro, current prices)







(% of total turnover in previous year in enterprises with at least 10 employees)













### Housing types in 2021 (%)






### Gross domestic energy consumption

# Renewable energy in gross final energy consumption (%)








### Potentially acidifying emissions


(million acid equivalents)






### Greenhouse gas emissions






### **Common bird-index**






### Road accidents with fatalities or casualties (number)









# Flemish public administration staff (number)



# Characteristics of Flemish administration staff in 2021° (% FTF)








# Revenues and expenditures of the Flemish government



of local governments




# Investment efforts of the Flemish government




### Official development assistance (ODA)

Satisfaction of the population (aged 18 and over) with policies in 2021 (score out of 10)




